

## **HATE**

**3404 miso (mis-eh'-o);**

from a primary misos (hatred); to detest (especially to persecute); by extension, **to love less: KJV-- hate (-ful).**

### **3404 (KJV)**

#### **Matt 5:43**

43 Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and **hate** thine enemy. (KJV)

#### **Matt 6:24**

24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will **hate** the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (KJV)

#### **Matt 10:22**

22 And ye shall be **hated** of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved. (KJV)

#### **Matt 24:9**

9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be **hated** of all nations for my name's sake. (KJV)

#### **Matt 24:10**

10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall **hate** one another. (KJV)

#### **Mark 13:13**

13 And ye shall be **hated** of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. (KJV)

#### **Luke 1:71**

71 That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that **hate** us; (KJV)

#### **Luke 6:22**

22 Blessed are ye, when men shall **hate** you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake. (KJV)

#### **Luke 6:27**

27 But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which **hate** you, (KJV)

**Luke 14:26**

26 If any man come to me, and **hate** not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. (KJV)

**Luke 16:13**

13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will **hate** the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (KJV)

**Luke 19:14**

14 But his citizens **hated** him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this man to reign over us. (KJV)

**Luke 21:17**

17 And ye shall be **hated** of all men for my name's sake. (KJV)

**John 3:20**

20 For every one that doeth evil **hateth** the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. (KJV)

**John 7:7**

7 The world cannot **hate** you; but me it **hateth**, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil. (KJV)

**John 12:25**

25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that **hateth** his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. (KJV)

**John 15:18**

18 If the world hate you, ye know that it **hated** me before it **hated** you. (KJV)

**John 15:19**

19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world **hateth** you. (KJV)

**John 15:23**

23 He that **hateth** me hateth my Father also. (KJV)

**John 15:24**

24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and **hated** both me and my Father. (KJV)

**John 15:25**

25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They **hated** me without a cause. (KJV)

**John 17:14**

14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath **hated** them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. (KJV)

**Rom 7:15**

15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I **hate**, that do I. (KJV)

**Rom 9:13**

13 As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I **hated**. (KJV)

**Eph 5:29**

29 For no man ever yet **hated** his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church: (KJV)

**Titus 3:3**

3 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, **hateful**, and **hating** one another. (KJV)

**Heb 1:9**

9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and **hated** iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. (KJV)

**I Jn 2:9**

9 He that saith he is in the light, and **hateth** his brother, is in darkness even until now. (KJV)

**I Jn 2:11**

11 But he that **hateth** his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. (KJV)

**I Jn 3:13**

13 Marvel not, my brethren, if the world **hate** you. (KJV)

**I Jn 3:15**

15 Whosoever **hateth** his brother is a **(2)murderer**: and ye know that no **murderer** hath eternal life abiding in him. (KJV)

**(2)murderer**

**443 anthropoktonos** (anth-ro-pok-ton'-os);

from 444 and kteine **(to kill)**; a **manslayer**: **KJV-- murderer. Compare 5406.**

**I Jn 4:20**

20 If a man say, I love God, and **hateth** his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? (KJV)

**Jude 1:23**

23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; **hating** even the garment spotted by the flesh. (KJV)

**Rev 2:6**

6 But this thou hast, that thou **hatest** the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also **hate**. (KJV)

**Rev 17:16**

16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall **hate** the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire. (KJV)

**Rev 18:2**

2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, **Babylon** the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and **hateful** bird. (KJV)
