

SALVATION

Salvation-4991 soteria (so-tay-ree'-ah); feminine of a derivative of 4990 as (properly, abstract) noun; rescue or safety (physically or morally), 1) deliverance, preservation, safety, salvation a) deliverance from the molestation of enemies b) in an ethical sense, what concludes to the souls safety or salvation; used of Messianic salvation 2) salvation as the present possession of all true Christians 3) future salvation, the sum of benefits and blessings which the Christians, redeemed from all earthly ills, will enjoy after the visible return of Christ from heaven in the consummated and eternal kingdom of God: **KJV-- deliver, health, salvation, save, saving.**

69 And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; (KJV)

Luke 1:71

71 That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; (KJV)

Luke 1:77

77 To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins, (KJV)

Luke 19:9

9 And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham. (KJV)

John 4:22

22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. (KJV)

12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. (KJV)

15 And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; (KJV)

3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. (KJV)

Rev 7:10

10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. (KJV)

Rev 12:10

10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. (KJV)

Salvation-4992 soterion (so-tay'-ree-on); neuter of the same as 4991 as (properly, concretely) noun; defender or (by implication) defence, 1) saving, bringing salvation 2) he who embodies this salvation, or through whom God is about to achieve it 3) the hope of (future) salvation: **KJV-- salvation.**

Luke 2:30

30 For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, (KJV)

Luke 3:6

6 And all flesh shall see the salvation of God. (KJV)

Acts 28:28

28 Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it. (KJV)

17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: (KJV)

Titus 2:11

11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, (KJV)

Saved by water-1295 diasozo (dee-as-odze'-o); from 1223 and 4982; to save thoroughly, i.e. (by implication or analogy) to cure, preserve, rescue, etc., 1) to preserve through danger, to bring safely through to save, that is, to cure one who is sick, to bring him through 2) to save, to keep from perishing 3) to save out of danger, to rescue: **KJV-- bring safe, escape (safe), heal, make perfectly whole, save.**

1 Pet 3:20

20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were **saved** by water. (KJV)

Spared not-5442 phulasso (foo-las'-so) probably from 5443 through the idea of isolation; to watch, i.e. be on guard (literally of figuratively); by implication, to preserve, obey, avoid, 1) to guard a) to watch, to keep watch b) to guard or to watch, to have an eye upon: lest he escape c) to guard a person (or thing) that he may remain safe 1) lest he suffer violence, be despoiled, etc., to protect 2) to protect one from a person or something 3) to keep from being snatched away, to preserve safe and unimpaired 4) to guard from being lost or perishing 5) to guard oneself from a thing d) to guard, that is, to care for,

take care not to violate, to observe 2) to observe for oneself something to escape: **KJV--
beward, keep (self), observe, save.**

2 Pet 2:5

5 And **spared** not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly; (KJV)
