

BY FAITH MOSES

Heb 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a **(1)proper** child; and they were not afraid of the **(2)king's (3)commandment. 24** By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

Definitions

(1)proper child-791 asteios (as-ti'-os); from astu (a city); urbane, i.e. (by implication) handsome, elegant (used of the body), comely, fair: KJV-- fair.

(2)king's-935 basileus-a leader of the people, a prince, a commander, a lord of the land, a king

(3)commandment-1297 diatagma (dee-at'-ag-mah); from 1299; an arrangement, i.e. (authoritative) edict, an injunction, a mandate: KJV-- commandment.

Heb 11:23 ... faith Moses, (KJV)

Exod 2:1-25

1 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi. **2** And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months. **3** And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid it in the flags by the river's brink. **4** And his sister stood afar off, to wit what would be done to him. **5** And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it. **6** And when she had opened it, she saw the child: and, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children. **7** Then said his sister to Pharaoh's daughter, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee? **8** And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother. **9** And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it. **10** And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water. **11** And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren. **12** And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand. **13** And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow? **14** And he said, Who made thee a prince and a judge over us? intendest thou to kill me, as thou killedst the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known. **15** Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well. **16** Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters: and they came and drew water, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. **17** And the shepherds came and drove them away: but Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock. **18** And when they came to Reuel their father, he said, How is it that ye are come so soon to day? **19** And they said, An Egyptian delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds, and also drew water enough for us, and watered the flock. **20** And he said unto his daughters, And where is he? why is it that ye have left the man? call him, that he may eat bread. **21** And Moses was content to dwell with the man: and he gave Moses Zipporah his daughter. **22** And she bare him a son, and he called his name Gershom: for he said, I have been a stranger in a strange land. **23** And it came to pass in process of time, that the king of Egypt died: and the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage. **24** And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with

Jacob. **25** And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God had respect unto them. (KJV)

Heb 11:23 ... a proper child; (KJV)

Num 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.) (KJV)

1 Sam 16:4-13

4 And Samuel did that which the LORD spake, and came to Bethlehem. And the elders of the town trembled at his coming, and said, Comest thou peaceably? **5** And he said, Peaceably: I am come to sacrifice unto the LORD: sanctify yourselves, and come with me to the sacrifice. And he sanctified Jesse and his sons, and called them to the sacrifice. **6** And it came to pass, when they were come, that he looked on Eliab, and said, Surely the LORD's anointed is before him. **7** But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart. **8** Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this. **9** Then Jesse made Shammah to pass by. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this. **10** Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these. **11** And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither. **12** And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he. **13** Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah. (KJV)

Acts 7:19-22

19 The same dealt subtilly with our kindred, and evil entreated our fathers, so that they cast out their young children, to the end they might not live. **20** In which time Moses was born, and was exceeding fair, and nourished up in his father's house three months: **21** And when he was cast out, Pharaoh's daughter took him up, and nourished him for her own son. **22** And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and in deeds. (KJV)

Heb 11:23 ... and they were not afraid of (KJV)

Ps 56:1-4

1 Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me. **2** Mine enemies would daily swallow me up: for they be many that fight against me, O thou most High. **3** What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee. **4** In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me. (KJV)

Ps 118:4-9

4 Let them now that fear the LORD say, that his mercy endureth for ever. **5** I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, and set me in a large place. **6** The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me? **7** The LORD taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire upon them that hate me. **8** It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man. **9** It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes. (KJV)

Isa 8:12-13

12 Say ye not, A (*)**confederacy**, to all them to whom this people shall say, A (*)**confederacy**; neither fear ye their fear, nor be afraid. **13** Sanctify the LORD of hosts himself; and let him be

your fear, and let him be your dread. (KJV)

Definition: (*)confederacy-7195 qesher (keh'-sher; from 7194; an (unlawful) alliance: KJV-- confederacy, conspiracy, treason.

Isa 41:10-14

10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. **11** Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish. **12** Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, even them that contended with thee: they that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought. **13** For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee. **14** Fear not, thou worm Jacob, and ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel. (KJV)

Isa 51:7 Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings. (KJV)

Isa 51:12-13

12 I, even I, am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass; **13** And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? and where is the fury of the oppressor? (KJV)

Matt 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (KJV)

Luke 12:4-5

4 And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. **5** But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him. (KJV)

Acts 4:16-20

16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it. **17** But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name. **18** And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. **19** **But Peter and John answered** and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. **20** For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.(KJV)

Heb 13:5-6

5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. **6** So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. (KJV)

Heb 11:23 ... the king's commandment. (KJV)

Exod 1:16-22

16 And he said, When ye do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the stools; if it be a son, then ye shall kill him: but if it be a daughter, then she shall live. **17** But

the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive. **18** And the king of Egypt called for the midwives, and said unto them, Why have ye done this thing, and have saved the men children alive? **19** And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women are not as the Egyptian women; for they are lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them. **20** Therefore God dealt well with the midwives: and the people multiplied, and waxed very mighty. **21** And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made them houses. **22** And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born ye shall cast into the river, and every daughter ye shall save alive. (KJV)

Heb 11:24 ... when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; (KJV)

Exod 2:10-12 (see also Acts 7:21-24)

10 And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water. **11** And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren. **12** And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand. (KJV)

Matt 4:7-11 (see also Luke 4:5-8)

7 Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. **8** Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; **9** And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. **10** Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. **11** Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him. (KJV)

Matt 16:22-26

22 Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee. **23** But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men. **24** Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. **25** For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it. **26** For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? (KJV)

Mark 10:28-31

28 Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee. **29** And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, **30** But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life. **31** But many that are first shall be last; and the last first. (KJV)

John 12:25-26

25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. **26** If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour. (KJV)

1Thes 1:1-10

1 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the

Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. **2** We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers; **3** Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father; **4** Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God. **5** For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know **what manner of men we were among you for your sake.** **6** And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost: **7** So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia. **8** For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing. **9** For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; **10** And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come. (See today's idols: **John12:25-26; Phil.3:16-20; 1 John2:15-17etc.**)
