

CHRISTIAN WOMEN-1

1 Tim 2:9 In like manner also, that **(1)women** adorn themselves in **(2)modest (3)apparel**, with **(4)shamefacedness** and **(5)sobriety**; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or **(6)costly array**;(KJV)

Definitions: **(1)women** -1135 gune (goo-nay'); probably from the base of 1096; a woman; specially, a wife: KJV-- wife, woman.1) a woman of any age, whether a virgin, or married, or a widow 2) a wife; used of a betrothed woman. **(2)modest-** 2887 kosmios (kos'-mee-os); from 2889 (in its primary sense); orderly, i.e. decorous: KJV-- of good behaviour, modest. **(3)apparel** -2689 katastole (kat-as-tol-ay'); from 2687; a deposit, i.e. (specially) costume: KJV-- apparel. **(4)shamefacedness-** 127 aidos (ahee-doce'); perhaps from 1 (as a negative particle) and 1492 (through the idea of downcast eyes); bashfulness, i.e. (towards men), modesty or (towards God) awe: KJV-- reverence, shamefacedness. **(5)sobriety-** 4997 sophrosune (so-fros-oo'-nay); from 4998; soundness of mind, i.e. (literally) sanity or (figuratively) self-control: KJV-- soberness, sobriety. **(6)costly array-** 2441 himatismos (him-at-is-mos'); from 2439; clothing: KJV-- apparel (X -led), array, raiment, vesture.

1 Tim 2:9 ... that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, (KJV)

1 Pet 3:3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; **4** But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price. **5** For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: (KJV)

14 And thy renown went forth among the heathen for thy beauty: for it was perfect through my comeliness, which I had put upon thee, saith the Lord GOD.

15 But thou didst trust in thine own beauty, and playedst the harlot because of thy renown, and pouredst out thy fornications on every one that passed by; his it was.

16 And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon: the like things shall not come, neither shall it be so. (KJV)

28 And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:

29 And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. (KJV)

JEZEBEL AND FACE PAINTING

II Ki 9:29-37

29 And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

30 And when Jehu was come to Jezreel, **Jezebel** heard of it; and **she painted her face**, and tired her head, and looked out at a window.

31 And as Jehu entered in at the gate, she said, Had Zimri peace, who slew his master?

32 And he lifted up his face to the window, and said, Who is on my side? who? And there looked out to him two or three eunuchs.

33 And he said, Throw her down. So they threw her down: and some of her blood was sprinkled on the wall, and on the horses: and he trode her under foot.

34 And when he was come in, he did eat and drink, and said, Go, see now this cursed woman, and bury her: for she is a king's daughter.

35 And they went to bury her: but they found no more of her than the skull, and the feet, and the palms of her hands.

36 Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he said, This is the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion of Jezreel shall dogs eat the flesh of Jezebel:

37 And the carcase of Jezebel shall be as dung upon the face of the field in the portion of Jezreel; so that they shall not say, This is Jezebel.(KJV)

Jer 4:30

42 And a voice of a multitude being at ease was with her: and with the men of the common sort were brought Sabeans from the wilderness, which put bracelets upon their hands, and beautiful crowns upon their heads.

43 Then said I unto her that was old in adulteries, Will they now commit whoredoms with her, and she with them?

44 Yet they went in unto her, as they go in unto a woman that playeth the harlot: so went they in unto Aholah and unto Aholibah, **the lewd women.**(KJV)

Rev 2:18-23

18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass;

19 I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first.

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works. (KJV)
