

## COMMENDETH HIMSELF 2 Cor 10:18

### 2 Cor 10:18

18 For not he that **(1) commendeth** himself is **(2)approved**, but whom the Lord **(1)commendeth**. (KJV)

**Definitions:** **(1) commendeth**-4921 sunistao (soon-is-tah'-o); or (strengthened) sunistano (soon-is-tan'-o); or sunistemi (soon-is'-tay-mee); from 4862 and 2476 (including its collat. forms); to set together, i.e. (by implication) to introduce (favorably), or (figuratively) to exhibit; intransitively, to stand near, or (figuratively) to constitute: KJV-- approve, commend, consist, make, stand (with). **(2)approved**-1384 dokimos (dok'-ee-mos); from 1380; properly, acceptable (current after assayal), i.e. approved:KJV-- approved, tried.

### 2 Cor 10:18 ... not he that commendeth himself is (KJV)

#### Prov 21:2

2 Every way of a man is right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts. (KJV)

#### Prov 27:2

2 Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips. (KJV)

#### Luke 16:15

15 And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God. (KJV)

#### Luke 18:10-14

10 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.  
11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.  
12 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.  
13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.  
14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted. (KJV)

#### 2 Cor 3:1

1 Do we begin again to commend ourselves? or need we, as some others, epistles of commendation to you, or letters of commendation from you? (KJV)

#### 2 Cor 5:12

12 For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to glory on our behalf, that ye may have somewhat to answer them which glory in appearance, and not in heart. (KJV)

**2 Cor 10:12**

12 For we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise. (KJV)

**2 Cor 10:18 ... approved, (KJV)****Acts 2:22**

22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: (KJV)

**Rom 14:18**

18 For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men. (KJV)

**Rom 16:10**

10 Salute Apelles approved in Christ. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' household. (KJV)

**1 Cor 11:19**

19 For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you. (KJV)

**2 Cor 6:4**

4 But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, (KJV)

**2 Cor 13:7**

7 Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates. (KJV)

**2 Tim 2:15**

15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (KJV)

**2 Cor 10:18 ... but whom the Lord commendeth. (KJV)****Matt 25:20-23**

20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

**John 5:42-44**

42 But I know you, that ye have not the love of God in you.

43 I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

44 How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only? (KJV)

**John 12:43**

43 For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God. (KJV)

**Rom 2:29**

29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God. (KJV)

**1 Cor 4:5**

5 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God. (KJV)

**1 Pet 1:7**

7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: (KJV)

**2 Cor 10:18 ... additional unclassified scriptures (KJV)****Prov 12:8**

8 A man shall be commended according to his wisdom: but he that is of a perverse heart shall be despised. (KJV)

**Matt 6:18**

18 That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly. (KJV)

**Matt 25:21**

21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. (KJV)

**Matt 26:13**

13 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a memorial of her. (KJV)

**Mark 14:6**

6 And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? she hath wrought a good work on me. (KJV)
