

DENY

533 *aparneomai* (ap-ar-neh'-om-ahee);
from 575 and 720; to deny utterly, i.e. disown, abstain:
to deny

- a) to affirm that one has no acquaintance or connection with someone
- b) to forget oneself, lose sight of oneself and one's own interests
KJV-- deny.

720 *arneomai* (ar-neh'-om-ahee);
perhaps from 1 (as a negative particle) and the middle voice of 4483; to contradict, i.e. disavow,
reject, abnegate:
1) to deny
2) to deny someone, to deny oneself
a) to disregard one's own interests or to prove false to himself
b) to act entirely unlike himself
3) to deny, abnegate, abjure
4) not to accept, to reject, to refuse something offered
KJV-- deny, refuse.

Matt 10:33

33 But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven. (KJV)

Matt 16:24

24 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. (KJV)

Matt 26:34

34 Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. (KJV)

Matt 26:35

35 Peter said unto him, Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee. Likewise also said all the disciples.(KJV)

Matt 26:70

70 But he denied before them all, saying, I know not what thou sayest. (KJV)

Matt 26:72

72 And again he denied with an oath, I do not know the man. (KJV)

Matt 26:75

75 And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly. (KJV)

Mark 8:34

34 And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. (KJV)

Mark 14:30

30 And Jesus saith unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this day, even in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. (KJV)

Mark 14:31

31 But he spake the more vehemently, If I should die with thee, I will not deny thee in any wise. Likewise also said they all. (KJV)

Mark 14:68

68 But he denied, saying, I know not, neither understand I what thou sayest. And he went out into the porch; and the cock crew. (KJV)

Mark 14:70

70 And he denied it again. And a little after, they that stood by said again to Peter, Surely thou art one of them: for thou art a Galilaean, and thy speech agreeth thereto. (KJV)

Mark 14:72

72 And the second time the cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Jesus said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought thereon, he wept. (KJV)

Luke 8:45

45 And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me? (KJV)

Luke 9:23

23 And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. (KJV)

Luke 12:9

9 But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God. (KJV)

Luke 22:34

34 And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me. (KJV)

Luke 22:57

57 And he denied him, saying, Woman, I know him not. (KJV)

Luke 22:61

61 And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. (KJV)

John 1:20

20 And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ. (KJV)

John 13:38

38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice. (KJV)

John 18:25

25 And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also one of his disciples? He denied it, and said, I am not. (KJV)

John 18:27

27 Peter then denied again: and immediately the cock crew. (KJV)

Acts 3:13

13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go. (KJV)

Acts 3:14

14 But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you; (KJV)

Acts 4:16

16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it. (KJV)

Acts 7:35

35 This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send to be a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush. (KJV)

1 Tim 5:8

8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel. (KJV)

2 Tim 2:12

12 If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: (KJV)

2 Tim 2:13

13 If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself. (KJV)

2 Tim 3:5

5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. (KJV)

Titus 1:16

16 They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate. (KJV)

Titus 2:12

12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; (KJV)

Heb 11:24

24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; (KJV)

2 Pet 2:1

1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. (KJV)

I Jn 2:22

22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. (KJV)

I Jn 2:23

23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also. (KJV)

Jude 1:4

4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. (KJV)

Rev 2:13

13 I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth. (KJV)

Rev 3:8

8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name. (KJV)
