

EXHORT ONE ANOTHER DAILY

Heb 3:1-19

- 1 Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;
- 2 Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house.
- 3 For this man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house.
- 4 For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God.
- 5 And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after;
- 6 But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.
- 7 Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice,
- 8 Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:
- 9 When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years.
- 10 Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways.
- 11 So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.)
- 12 Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
- 13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.
- 14 For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;
- 15 While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.
- 16 For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.
- 17 But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness?
- 18 And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not?
- 19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.(KJV)

Heb 3:13 But (1)exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be (2)hardened through the (3)deceitfulness of (4)sin.(KJV)

Definition: (1)exhort one another daily-3870 parakaleo (par-ak-al-eh'-o); from 3844 and 2564; to call near, i.e. invite, invoke (by imploration, hortation or consolation): KJV-- beseech, call for, (be of good) comfort, desire, (give) exhort (-ation), intreat, pray.a) to admonish, to exhort c) to console, to encourage and strengthen by consolation, to comfort, to receive consolation, to be comforted d) to encourage, to strengthen f) to

instruct, to teach. **(2)hardened**-4645 skleruno (sklay-roo'-no); from 4642; to indurate, i.e. (figuratively) render stubborn: **KJV-- harden**. **(3)deceitfulness**-539 apate (ap-at'-ay); from 538; delusion: **KJV-- deceit** (-ful, -fulness), deceivableness (-ving). **(4)sin**-266 hamartia (ham-ar-tee'-ah); from **264**; a sin (properly abstract): **KJV-- offence, sin (-ful)**.b) to miss the mark c) to err, be mistaken d) to miss or wander from the path of uprightness and honor, to do or go wrong e) to wander from the law of God, to violate God's law, to sin 2) that which is done wrong, sin, an offence, a violation of the divine law in thought or in act

Heb 3:13 ... exhort one another (KJV)

Acts 11:23

23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord. (KJV)

1Thes 2:11

11 As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children, (KJV)

1Thes 4:18

18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words. (KJV)

1Thes 5:11

11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do. (KJV)

2 Tim 4:2

2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. (KJV)

Heb 10:24-25

24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. (KJV)

3 The pride of thine heart hath deceived thee, thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that saith in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground? (KJV)

Rom 7:11

11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me. (KJV)

Eph 4:22

22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; (KJV)

James 1:14

14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. (KJV)

Heb 3:13 ... additional scriptures (KJV)

Gen 11:3

3 And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them throughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar. (KJV)

Exod 7:13

13 And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said. (KJV)

Lev 7:15

15 And the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings for thanksgiving shall be eaten the same day that it is offered; he shall not leave any of it until the morning. (KJV)

Lev 8:32

32 And that which remaineth of the flesh and of the bread shall ye burn with fire. (KJV)

1 Sam 6:6

6 Wherefore then do ye harden your hearts, as the Egyptians and Pharaoh hardened their hearts? when he had wrought wonderfully among them, did they not let the people go, and they departed? (KJV)

2 Chr 14:7

7 Therefore he said unto Judah, Let us build these cities, and make about them walls, and towers, gates, and bars, while the land is yet before us; because we have sought the

LORD our God, we have sought him, and he hath given us rest on every side. So they built and prospered. (KJV)

2 Chr 36:13

13 And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he stiffened his neck, and hardened his heart from turning unto the LORD God of Israel. (KJV)

Neh 9:16

16 But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments, (KJV)

Ps 95:7-8

7 For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice,

8 Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, and as in the day of temptation in the wilderness: (KJV)

Isa 48:4

4 Because I knew that thou art obstinate, and thy neck is an iron sinew, and thy brow brass; (KJV)

Isa 55:6

6 Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: (KJV)

Ezek 11:21

21 But as for them whose heart walketh after the heart of their detestable things and their abominations, I will recompense their way upon their own heads, saith the Lord GOD. (KJV)

Dan 5:20

20 But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him: (KJV)

Mal 3:16

16 Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. (KJV)

Matt 5:25

25 Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison. (KJV)

Luke 19:42

42 Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes. (KJV)

John 3:19

19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. (KJV)

Acts 2:40

40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. (KJV)

Acts 19:9

9 But when divers were hardened, and believed not, but spake evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the school of one Tyrannus. (KJV)

Acts 24:25

25 And as he reasoned of righteousness, temperance, and judgment to come, Felix trembled, and answered, Go thy way for this time; when I have a convenient season, I will call for thee. (KJV)

Rom 2:5

5 But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God; (KJV)

Rom 2:8

8 But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, (KJV)

1 Cor 14:3

3 But he that prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. (KJV)

2 Cor 6:2

2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.) (KJV)

II Th 2:10

10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. (KJV)

1 Tim 6:5

5 Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. (KJV)

Heb 10:25

25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. (KJV)

Heb 13:22

22 And I beseech you, brethren, suffer the word of exhortation: for I have written a letter unto you in few words. (KJV)
