Matt 5:43-46

43 **Ye have heard that it hath been said**, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy.

44 **But I say unto you, Love your enemies**, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: **for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.**

46 For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?(KJV)

Matt 7:21-23

21 **Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven**; but he that **doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.**

22 **Many will say to me** in that day, **Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name?** and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

23 And then will I profess unto them, **I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.**(KJV)

John 8:46-47

46 Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me?

47 **He that is of God heareth God's words**: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.(KJV)

Matt 17:1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart, **2** And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light. **3** And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him. **4** **Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.** **5** **While he yet spake**, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.** **6** And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid. **7** And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid. **8** And when they had lifted up their eyes, **they saw no man, save Jesus only.**(KJV)

Mark 16:15-16

15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

16 **He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved**; but he that believeth not shall be damned.(KJV)

1 Pet 3:21-4:1

21 The like figure whereunto **even baptism doth also now save us** (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

22 Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and

powers being made subject unto him.

CHAPTER 4

1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: **for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;**(KJV)

Rom 10:16-17

16 **But they have not all obeyed the gospel.** For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?

17 So then **faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.**(KJV)

Eph 2:7-8

7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

8 **For by grace are ye saved through faith;** and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:(KJV)

Gal 3:24-29

24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

25 But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.

26 For ye are all the children of God **by faith in Christ Jesus.**

27 **For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.**

28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

29 **And if ye be Christ's,** then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. (KJV)

Col 2:11-12

11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

12 **Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God,** who hath raised him from the dead. (KJV)

Matt 16:17-18

17 And **Jesus answered and said unto him,** Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock **I will build my church;** and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.(KJV)

Eph 3:19-21

19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

21 **Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus** throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.(KJV)

Eph 4:1-6

1 I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,
2 With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;
3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
4 **There is one body, and one Spirit,** even as ye are called in **one hope of your calling;**
5 **One Lord, one faith, one baptism,**
6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.(KJV)

2 Cor 13:5

5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?(KJV)

1Thes 5:21

21 **Prove all things;** hold fast that which is good.(KJV)

James 1:9-10

9 Let the brother of low degree rejoice in that he is exalted:
10 **But the rich, in that he is made low:** because as the flower of the grass **he shall pass away.**(KJV)

James 1:21-22

21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and **receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.**
22 **But be ye doers of the word,** and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.(KJV)

James 2:5

5 Hearken, my beloved brethren, **Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith,** and **heirs of the kingdom** which he hath promised to them that love him?(KJV)

James 2:17 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. **18** Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. **19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. 20** But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?(KJV)

2 Cor 11:13-15

13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.
14 **And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.**
15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.(KJV)
