

IN THE LORD

Gal 3:23 But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. **24** Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. **25** But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. **26** For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. **27** For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. **28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. **29** And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.(KJV)

Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been **baptized into Christ** have **(1)put on Christ**.(KJV)

Definition: (1)put on Christ-1746 enduo (en-doo'-o); from 1722 and 1416 (in the sense of sinking into a garment); to invest with clothing (literally or figuratively): KJV-- array, clothe (with), endue, have (put) on. to clothe oneself

Gal 3:27 ... as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have (KJV)

Matt 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. **19** Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: **20** Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.(KJV)

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. (KJV)

Acts 8:35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. **36** And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized? **37** And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. **38** And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. **39** And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.(KJV)

Acts 9:17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. **18** And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized.(KJV)

Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul. **15** And when she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us.(KJV)

Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. **32** And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. **33** And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway. **34** And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, believing in God with all his house.(KJV)

Rom 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized **into Jesus Christ** were baptized into his death? **4** Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.(KJV)

1 Cor 12:12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. **13** For by one Spirit are we all baptized **into one body**, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink **into one Spirit**. (KJV)

Col 2:5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your **faith in Christ**. **6** As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so **walk ye in him**: **7** Rooted and built up **in him**, and stablished **in the faith**, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. **8** Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. **9** For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. **10** And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power: **11** In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: **12** Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.(KJV)

1 Pet 3:20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. **21** The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ: **22** Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

1 Pet 4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin; **2** That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.(KJV)

Gal 3:27 ... put on Christ. (KJV)

Rom 3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; **22** Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: **23** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; **24** Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is **in Christ Jesus**: (KJV)

Rom 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. **13** Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. **14** But **put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.(KJV)

Eph 4:20 But ye have not so learned Christ; **21** If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, **as the truth is in Jesus**: **22** That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; **23** And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; **24** And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. (KJV)

Phil 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; **28** And in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God. **29** For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake; **30** Having the same conflict which ye saw in me, and now hear to be in me.(KJV)

Col 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. **2** Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. **3** For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. **4** When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory. **5** Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: **6** For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience: **7** In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them. **8** But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. **9** Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; **10** And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him: **11** Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all. **12** Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;(KJV)

Additional scriptures (KJV)

Rom 16:1 I commend unto you Phebe our sister, which is a servant of the church which is at Cenchrea: **2** That ye receive her **in the Lord**, as becometh saints, and that ye assist

her in whatsoever business she hath need of you: for she hath been a succourer of many, and of myself also. **3** Greet Priscilla and Aquila my helpers **in Christ Jesus**: **4** Who have for my life laid down their own necks: unto whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles. **5** Likewise greet the church that is in their house. Salute my wellbeloved Epaphroditus, who is the firstfruits of Achaia unto Christ. **6** Greet Mary, who bestowed much labour on us. **7** Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me. **8** Greet Amplias my **beloved in the Lord**. **9** Salute Urbane, our helper in Christ, and Stachys my beloved. **10** Salute Apelles approved in Christ. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' household. **11** Salute Herodion my kinsman. Greet them that be of the household of Narcissus, which are **in the Lord**. **12** Salute Tryphena and Tryphosa, who labour in the Lord. Salute the beloved Persis, which laboured much **in the Lord**. **13** Salute Rufus chosen **in the Lord**, and his mother and mine. **14** Salute Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the brethren which are with them. **15** Salute Philologus, and Julia, Nereus, and his sister, and Olympas, and all the saints which are with them. **16** Salute one another with an holy kiss. The **churches of Christ** salute you. **17** Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them. **18** For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple. **19** For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil. **20** And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen. **21** Timotheus my workfellow, and Lucius, and Jason, and Sosipater, my kinsmen, salute you. **22** I Tertius, who wrote this epistle, salute you **in the Lord**. **23** Gaius mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a brother. **24** The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.(KJV)

1 Cor 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: **31** That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory **in the Lord**.(KJV)

1 Cor 4:17 For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and **faithful in the Lord**, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be **in Christ**, as I teach every where in every church.(KJV)

1 Cor 7:22 For he that is called **in the Lord**, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, being free, is Christ's servant. **23** Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.(KJV)

1 Cor 7:39 The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; **only in the Lord**.

1 Cor 9:1 Am I not an apostle? am I not free? have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord? are not ye my work **in the Lord**? **2** If I be not an apostle unto others, yet doubtless I am to you: for the seal of mine apostleship are **ye in the Lord**.(KJV)

1 Cor 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always **abounding in the work of the Lord**, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain **in the Lord**. (KJV)

1 Cor 16:19 The churches of Asia salute you. Aquila and Priscilla salute you much **in the Lord**, with the church that is in their house. **20** All the brethren greet you. Greet ye one another with an holy kiss. **21** The salutation of me Paul with mine own hand. **22** If any man love not the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be Anathema Maranatha. **23** The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. **24** My love be with you all **in Christ Jesus. Amen.**

Eph 5:6 Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. **7** Be not ye therefore partakers with them. **8** For ye were sometimes darkness, **but now are ye light in the Lord**: walk as children of light: **9** (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) **10** Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord. **11** And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.(KJV)

Eph 6:1 Children, obey your parents **in the Lord**: for this is right.(KJV)

Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be **strong in the Lord**, and in the power of his might.(KJV)

Eph 6:21 But that ye also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful **minister in the Lord**, shall make known to you all things:(KJV)

Phil 1:14 And many of the **brethren in the Lord**, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.(KJV)

Phil 2:29 Receive him **therefore in the Lord** with all gladness; and hold such in reputation: **30** Because for the work of Christ he was nigh unto death, not regarding his life, to supply your lack of service toward me.(KJV)

Phil 3:1 Finally, my brethren, **rejoice in the Lord**. To write the same things to you, to me indeed is not grievous, but for you it is safe.(KJV)

Phil 4:1 Therefore, my brethren dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so **stand fast in the Lord**, my dearly beloved. **2** I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of the **same mind in the Lord**. **3** And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life. **4 Rejoice in the Lord alway**: and again I say, Rejoice.(KJV)

Col 3:18 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, **as it is fit in the Lord**. **19** Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.(KJV)

Col 4:7 All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, who is a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and **fellow servant in the Lord**:(KJV)

1Thes 1:1 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and **in the Lord Jesus Christ**: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.(KJV)

1Thes 3:8 For now we live, if ye **stand fast in the Lord**.(KJV)

1Thes 5:12 And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are **over you in the Lord**, and admonish you; **13** And to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. And be at peace among yourselves. **14** Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feeble minded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.(KJV)

Phile 1:15 For perhaps he therefore departed for a season, that thou shouldest receive him for ever; **16** Not now as a servant, but above a servant, a brother beloved, specially to me, but how much more unto thee, **both in the flesh, and in the Lord**? **17** If thou count me therefore a partner, receive him as myself.(KJV)

Phile 1:20 Yea, brother, let me have joy of thee **in the Lord**: refresh my bowels **in the Lord**. (KJV)

The World:

ANYTHING or ANYONE that has not been baptized into Christ, according to New Testament scripture!

Luke 16:13 (1)No (2)servant can (3)serve two (4)masters: for either **(5)he will hate** the one, and **(6)love the other**; or else **(7)he will hold to** the one, and **(8)despise** the other. Ye cannot **serve** God and **(9)mammon**. **14** And the Pharisees also, who were **(10)covetous**, heard all these things: and **(11)they derided** him. **15** And he said unto them, Ye are they which **(12)justify** yourselves **(13)before** men; but God knoweth your hearts: for **(14)that which is highly esteemed** among men is **(15)abomination** in the sight of God. (KJV)

Definitions: **(1)No**-3762 oudeis (including the feminine, oudemia, and the neuter, ouden)-no one, nothing. **(2)servant**-3610 oiketēs-one who lives in the same house as another, spoken of all who are under the authority of one and the same householder, a servant, a domestic. **(3)can serve**-1398 douleuo-1) to be a slave, serve, to do service; used of a nation in subjection to other nations 2) metaphorically, to obey, to submit to a) in a good sense, to yield obedience b) in a bad sense, of those who become slaves to some base power, to yield to, to give oneself up to. **(4)two masters**-2962 kurios (koo'-ree-os); from kuros (supremacy); supreme in authority, i.e. (as noun) controller; by implication, Mr. (as a respectful title), he to whom a person or thing belongs, about which he has power of deciding; master, lord, a) the possessor and disposer of a thing 1) the owner; one who has control of the person, the master: KJV-- God, Lord, master, Sir. **(5)for either he will hate** the one-3404 miseo (mis-eh'-o); from a primary misos (hatred); to

detest (especially to persecute); by extension, to love less: KJV-- hate (-ful). **(6)and love the other** 25 agapao-1) used of persons: to welcome, to entertain, to be fond of, to love dearly 2) used of things: to be well pleased, to be contented at or with a thing. **(7)or else he will hold to** the one-472 antechomai (an-tekh'-om-ahee); from 473 and the middle voice of 2192; to hold oneself opposite to, 2) to keep oneself directly opposite to anyone, hold to him firmly, cleave to, paying heed to him, adhere to; by extension to care for: KJV-- hold fast, hold to, support. **(8)and despise** the other-2706 kataphroneo (kat-af-ron-eh'-o); from 2596 and 5426; to think against, i.e. disesteem, to think little or nothing of: KJV--to despise, to contemn, to disdain. **(9)Ye cannot serve God and mammon**-3126 mammonas-1) mammon 2) treasure 3) riches (where it is personified and opposed to God). **(10)covetous**-5366 philarguros (fil-ar'-goo-ros); from 5384 and 696; fond of silver (money), i.e. avaricious: KJV—covetous, loving money, avarice. **(11)they derided** him-1592 ekmukterizo-to deride by turning up the nose, to sneer at, to scoff at **(12)Ye are they which justify yourselves**-1344 dikaioo (dik-ah-yo'-o);from 1342; to render (i.e. show or regard as) just or innocent: KJV-- free, justify (-ier), be righteous. **(13)before** men-1799 enopion-in the presence of, before. **(14)for that which is highly esteemed** among men-5308 hupselos (hoop-say-los'); from 5311; lofty (in place or character), 2) metaphorically, eminent, exalted a) in influence and honor b) to set the mind on, to seek, high things (as honors and riches), to be aspiring: KJV-- high (-er, -ly) (esteemed). **(15)is abomination** in the sight of God-946 bdelugma (bdel'-oog-mah);from 948; a detestation, i.e. (specially) idolatry, a foul thing, a detestable thing; used of idols and things pertaining to idolatry: KJV-- abomination.

John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. **25 (1)He that loveth his life shall lose it;** and **(2)he that hateth** his life in this **(3)world shall keep it unto life eternal.** **26 If any man serve me, let him follow me;** and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.(KJV)

Definitions: **(1)He that loveth** his life shall lose it-5368 phileo (fil-eh'-o); from 5384; to be a friend to (fond of [an individual or an object]), i.e. have affection for (denoting personal attachment, as a matter of sentiment or feeling; to kiss (as a mark of tenderness), a) to approve of b) to like c) to sanction d) to treat affectionately or kindly, to welcome, to befriend 2) to show signs of love; to kiss 3) to be fond of doing; (something): KJV-- kiss, love. **(2)and he that hateth** his life-3404 miseo (mis-eh'-o);from a primary misos (hatred); to detest (especially to persecute); by extension, to love less, 2) to be hated, to be detested: KJV-- hate (-ful). **(3)in this world shall keep it unto life eternal**-2889 kosmos-1) an apt and harmonious arrangement or constitution, order, government 2) ornament, decoration, adornment, that is, the arrangement of the stars, 'the heavenly hosts', as the ornament of the heavens. 1 Pet. 3:3 3) the world, the universe 4) the circle of the earth, the earth 5) the inhabitants of the earth, men, the human race 6) the ungodly multitude; the whole mass of men alienated from God, and therefore hostile to the cause of Christ 7) world affairs, the aggregate of things earthly the whole circle of earthly goods, endowments riches, advantages, pleasures, etc., which although hollow and frail and fleeting, stir desire, seduce from God and are obstacles to the cause of Christ.

John 15:18 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. **19** If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. **20** Remember the word that I said unto you, **The servant is not greater than his lord.** If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.(KJV)

John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. **6** I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.(KJV)

John 17:14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. **15** I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. **16** They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. **17** Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. **18** As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. **19** And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. **20** Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through *their word; **21** That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. (see***their word:** Matt.28:18-20; Acts 1:1-3; 2:41-42; 1Cor.11:1-3; Phil.3:17; 2Pet.3:1-3; 1John4:5-6; Jude 1:17-19.)

2 Cor 4:3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: **4** In whom **the god of this world** hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. **5** For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. **6** For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Cor 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? **15** And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? **16** And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. **17** **Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,** **18** And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

2 Cor 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.(KJV)

Gal 6:14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.(KJV)

Eph 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: **3** Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.(KJV)

James 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

I Jn 2:15 **(1)Love not the (2)world, neither the things that are in the world.** If any man love the world, the **(3)love of the Father is not in him.** **16 For all that is in the world**, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. **17** And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. **18** Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. **19** They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.(KJV)
