

INHERITANCE

Inherit-2816 kleronomeo (klay-ron-om-eh'-o);from 2818; to be an heir to (literally or figuratively): KJV-- be heir, (obtain by) inherit (-ance). **(KJV)**

Matt 5:5

5 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. **(KJV)**

Matt 19:29

29 And every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my name's sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life. **(KJV)**

Matt 25:34

34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: **(KJV)**

Mark 10:17

17 And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? **(KJV)**

Luke 10:25

25 And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? **(KJV)**

Luke 18:18

18 And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? **(KJV)**

1 Cor 6:9

Gal 5:21

21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. (KJV)

Heb 1:4

4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they. (KJV)

Heb 1:14

14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation? (KJV)

Heb 6:12

12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises. (KJV)

Heb 12:17

17 For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears. (KJV)

1 Pet 3:9

9 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing. (KJV)

Rev 21:7

7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. (KJV)

Inheritance-2817 kleronomia (klay-ron-om-ee'-ah);from 2818; heirship, i.e. (concretely) a patrimony or (genitive case) a possession, 1) an inheritance, property received (or to be received) by inheritance 2) what is given to one as a possession a) the eternal blessedness of the consummated kingdom of God which is to be expected after the visible return of Christ b) the share which an individual will have in that eternal blessedness: KJV-- inheritance. **(KJV)**

Acts 20:32

32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

Gal 3:18

18 For if the inheritance be of the law, it is no more of promise: but God gave it to Abraham by promise. (KJV)

Eph 1:14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. (KJV)

Eph 1:18

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, (KJV)

Eph 5:5

5 For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. (KJV)

Col 3:24

24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. (KJV)

Heb 9:15

15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. (KJV)

Heb 11:8

8 By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. (KJV)

1 Pet 1:4

4 To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, (KJV)

Heir-2818 kleronomos (klay-ron-om'-os); from 2819 and the base of 3551 (in its original sense of partitioning, i.e. [reflexively] getting by apportionment); a sharer by lot, i.e. inheritor (literally or figuratively); by implication, a possessor:KJV-- heir. (KJV)

Rom 4:13

13 For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. (KJV)

Rom 4:14

14 For if they which are of the law be heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect: (KJV)

Rom 8:17

17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. (KJV)

Gal 3:29

29 And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. (KJV)

Gal 4:1

1 Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; (KJV)

Gal 4:7

7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. (KJV)

Titus 3:7

7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. (KJV)

Heb 1:2

2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; (KJV)

Heb 6:17

17 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: (KJV)

Heb 11:7

7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. (KJV)

James 2:5

5 Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him? (KJV)

heritage, inheritance, lot, part-2819 kleros (klay'-ros);probably from 2806 (through the idea of using bits of wood, etc., for the purpose); a die (for drawing chances); by implication a portion (as if so secured); by extension an acquisition (especially a patrimony, figuratively); KJV-- heritage, inheritance, lot, part. (KJV)

Matt 27:35

35 And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots. (KJV)

Luke 23:34

34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. (KJV)

John 19:24 They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did. (KJV)

Acts 26:18

obtain an inheritance-2820 kleroo (klay-ro'-o); from 2819; to allot, i.e. (figuratively) to assign (a privilege): KJV-- obtain an inheritance. **(KJV)**

Eph 1:11-14

11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.

13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. (KJV)
