

JOINT-HEIRS WITH CHRIST

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; (1)heirs of God, and (2)joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also (3)glorified together.(KJV)

Definitions: (1)heirs of God-2818 kleronomos (klay-ron-om'-os); from 2819 and the base of 3551 (in its original sense of partitioning, i.e. [reflexively] getting by apportionment); a sharer by lot, i.e. inheritor (literally or figuratively); by implication, a possessor, 1) one who receives by lot, an heir a) an heir b) in Messianic usage, one who receives his allotted possession by right of sonship 2) one who has acquired or obtained the portion allotted to him: KJV-- heir.

(2)joint-heirs with Christ-4789 sugkleronomos (soong-klay-ron-om'-os);from **4862** and 2818; a co-heir, i.e. (by analogy) participant in common, 1) a fellow heir, a joint heir 2) one who obtains something assigned to himself with others, a joint participant: KJV-- fellow (joint)- heir, heir together, heir with. **4862** sun (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together (but much closer than 3326 or 3844), i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.: KJV-- beside, with. In composition it has similar applications, including completeness.

(3)glorified together-4888 sundoxazo (soon-dox-ad'-zo); from **4862** and **1392**; to exalt to dignity in company (i.e. similarly) with, 1) to approve together, to join in approving 2) to glorify together: KJV-- glorify together. **4862** sun (soon); a primary preposition denoting union; with or together (but much closer than **3326** or 3844), i.e. by association, companionship, process, resemblance, possession, instrumentality, addition, etc.: KJV-- beside, with. In composition it has similar applications, including completeness. **3326** meta (met-ah'); a primary preposition (often used adverbially); properly, denoting accompaniment; "amid" (local or causal); modified variously according to the case (genitive case association, or accusative case succession) with which it is joined; occupying an intermediate position between 575 or 1537 and 1519 or 4314; less intimate than 1722 and less close than 4862): KJV-- after (-ward), X that he again, against, among, X and, + follow, hence, hereafter, in, of, (up-) on, + our, X and setting, since, (un-) to, + together, when, with (+-out). Often used in composition, in substantially the same relations of participation or proximity, and transfer or sequence. **1392** doxazo (dox-ad'-zo); from 1391; to render (or esteem) glorious (in a wide application), 1) to think, to suppose, to be of opinion 2) to praise, to extol, to magnify, to celebrate 3) to honor, to do honor to, to hold in honor 4) to make glorious, to adorn with lustre, to clothe with splendor a) to impart glory to something, to render it excellent b) to make renowned, to render illustrious, to cause the dignity and worth of some person or thing to become manifest and acknowledged: KJV-- (make) glorify (-ious), full of (have) glory, honour, magnify.

Phil 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake; (KJV)

2 Tim 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. **11** It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: **12** If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will

deny us: **13** If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself. **14** Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers. (KJV)

II Th 1:3 We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth; **4** So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure: **5** Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also suffer: **6** Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; **7** And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, **8** In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: **9** Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; **10** When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day. (KJV)

II Th 2:14 Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. (KJV)

2 Tim 1:8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; (KJV)

2 Tim 2:12 If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: (KJV)

Heb 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, **2** Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; (KJV)

Heb 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment. **24** By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; **25** Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season; **26** Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward. **27** By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible. (KJV)

James 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; (KJV)

James 1:9 Let the brother of low degree rejoice in that he is exalted: (KJV)

1 Pet 4:12 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: **13** But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy. **14** If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified. **15** But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. **16** Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf. **17** For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? **18** And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? **19** Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator. (KJV)

1 Pet 5:1 The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed: (KJV)

1 Jn 3:10 In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. (KJV)

Rev 1:9 I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. (KJV)

Rev 3:21 To him **(1)that overcometh** will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne. **22** He that hath an ear, let him hear what

the Spirit saith unto the churches. (KJV)

Definitions: (1)that overcometh-3528 nikao (nik-ah'-o); from 3529; to subdue (literally or figuratively), 1) used of Christ, victorious who was over all His foes 2) used of Christians who hold fast their faith even unto death against the power of their foes, and temptations, and persecutions: KJV-- conquer, overcome, prevail, get the victory.
