LAST COMMANDMENT SPOKEN FROM GOD THE FATHER?  
“HEAR YE HIM”  
Matt.17:5**

**John 8:47**

47 **He that is of God heareth God's words:** ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.(KJV)

**Matt 17:1-8**

1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,  
2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.  
3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.  
4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: **if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.**  
5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**  
6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.  
7 And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid.  
8 And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, **save Jesus only.**(KJV)

**Matt 17:5**

5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**(KJV)

**Matt 17:5 ... This is my beloved Son, (KJV)**

**Matt 27:50-54**

50 Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.  
51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;  
52 **And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,**  
53 **And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.**  
54 Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, **saying, Truly this was the Son of God.**(KJV)

**Mark 9:7**

7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him. (KJV) (see also Luke 3:22 & John 3:16)

**John 3:35**

35 The Father loveth the Son, and **hath given all things into his hand.** (KJV)

**John 5:22-23 (see also verses 20-21)**

22 For the Father judgeth no man, **but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:**  
23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. (KJV)

**Eph 1:5-6 (see also verses 7-8)**

5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children **by Jesus Christ** to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,  
6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

**Col 1:13**

13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath **translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:** (KJV)

**2 Pet 1:16-17**

16 For **we have not followed cunningly devised fables**, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.  
17 For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.** (KJV)

**Matt 17:5 ... in whom I am well pleased; (KJV)**

**Isa 42:1**

1 Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: **he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.** (KJV)

**Isa 53:1 (see also verses 2-12)**

1 Who hath believed our report? and **to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?**

**Matt 12:18**

18 Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, **and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.** (KJV)

**John 15:9-10**

9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.  
10 **If ye keep my commandments**, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. (KJV)

**Matt 17:5 ... hear ye him. (KJV)**

**Deut 18:15 (see verse 19)**

15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken; (KJV)

**Matt 28:16-20**

16 Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had

appointed them.

17 And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted.

18 **And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.**

19 **Go ye therefore, and teach all nations,** baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

20 **Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you:** and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.(KJV)

#### **Luke 24:44**

44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which **were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.**(KJV)

#### **John 1:17** (see also verses 15-16)

17 For **the law was given by Moses,** but **grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.**(KJV)

#### **John 8:58**

58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Before Abraham was, I am.**(KJV)

#### **Acts 3:22** (see also verse 23)

22 For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; **him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.**

#### **Acts 7:37**

37 This is that Moses, which said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; **him shall ye hear.** (KJV)

#### **Rom 10:1-6**

1 **Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.**

2 For I bear them record **that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.**

3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and **going about to establish their own righteousness,** have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.

4 **For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.**

5 **For Moses describeth the righteousness which is of the law, That the man which doeth those things shall live by them.**

6 **But the righteousness which is of faith** speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:)(KJV)

#### **1 Cor 9:21**

21 To them that are without law, as without law, (being not without law to God, **but under the law to Christ,**) that I might gain them that are without law.(KJV)

**2 Cor 3:4-6 (see verses 3, 7, & 8)**

4 And such trust have we **through Christ** to God-ward:

5 Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;

6 **Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament**; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.(KJV)

**Gal 2:16**

16 Knowing that a man is **not justified by the works of the law**, but **by the faith of Jesus Christ**, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.(KJV)

**Gal 2:21**

21 **I do not frustrate the grace of God**: for if **righteousness come by the law**, then **Christ is dead in vain**.(KJV)

**Gal 3:2**

2 This only would I learn of you, **Received ye the Spirit** by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?(KJV)

**Gal 3:10-13**

10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

12 **And the law is not of faith**: but, **The man that doeth them shall live in them**.

13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:(KJV)

**Gal 3:23-27**

23 **But before faith came**, we were **kept under the law**, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed.

24 Wherefore **the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ**, that we might be justified by faith.

25 But **after that faith is come**, we are **no longer under a schoolmaster**.

26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

27 For as many of you as have been **baptized into Christ have put on Christ**.(KJV)

**Gal 5:3-4**

3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor **to do the whole law**.

4 **Christ is become of no effect unto you**, whosoever of you are justified by the law; **ye are fallen from grace**.(KJV)

**Gal 6:2**

2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil **the law of Christ**.(KJV)

### **Phil 3:7-10**

7 But what things were gain to me, those **I counted loss for Christ**.

8 Yea doubtless, and **I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord**: for whom **I have suffered the loss of all things**, and **do count them but dung**, that **I may win Christ**,

9 And be **found in him, not having mine own righteousness**, which **is of the law**, but that which is **through the faith of Christ**, the **righteousness which is of God by faith**:

10 That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;(KJV)

### **Col 3:16-17**

16 **Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom**; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

17 And **whatsoever ye do in word or deed**, do **all in the name of the Lord Jesus**, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.(KJV)

### **1 Tim 2:5-6**

5 For there is one God, and **one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus**;

6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.(KJV)

### **Heb 1:1-2**

1 God, who at **sundry times** and in **divers manners** spake **in time past** unto the fathers **by the prophets**,

2 **Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; (KJV)

### **Heb 2:1-3**

1 Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.

2 **For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward**;

3 **How shall we escape**, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him; (KJV)

### **Heb 3:14-15**

14 For we are made **partakers of Christ**, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

15 While it is said, To day **if ye will hear his voice**, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.(KJV)

### **Heb 5:9**

9 And being made perfect, **he became the author of eternal salvation** unto **all them that obey him**; (KJV) (JesusChrist)

**Heb 8:6**

6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also **he is the mediator of a better covenant**, which was established upon **better promises**.(KJV)

**Heb 9:15 (see verse14)**

15 **And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament**, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.(KJV)

**Heb 12:24**

24 And to **Jesus the mediator of the new covenant**, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.(KJV)

**Acts 11:25-26**

25 Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul:

26 And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with **the church**, and taught much people. **And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch**.(KJV)

**Acts 20:7**

7 **And upon the first day of the week**, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.(KJV)

**1 Cor 16:1-2**

1 Now concerning **the collection for the saints**, as **I have given order** to the churches of Galatia, **even so do ye**.

2 **Upon the first day of the week** let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.(KJV) (see **2Cor.8:11-15 & 2Cor.9:6-9**)

**Rev 1:9-10**

9 I John, who also am your brother, and **companion in tribulation**, and in the kingdom and patience **of Jesus Christ**, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the **testimony of Jesus Christ**.

10 **I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day**, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet
