

**NOW LET'S LOOK
DEEPER INTO HEBREWS 13:4**

Heb 13:4

4 Marriage is **(1)honourable** in **(2)all**, and the **(3)bed** **(4)undefiled**: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge.(KJV)

DEFINITIONS

1) 5093 timios- HONOURABLE: as of great price, precious, held in honor, esteemed, especially dear

(2) 3956 pas- ALL

individually: each, every, any, all, the whole, everyone, all things, everything

(3) 2845 koite (koy'-tay); BED

from 2749; a couch; by extension cohabitation; by implication, the male sperm: KJV-- bed, chambering, X conceive, a place for laying down, resting, sleeping in a bed, a couch, the marriage bed; used of adultery, cohabitation, whether lawful or unlawful; sexual intercourse

(4) 283 amiantos (am-ee'-an-tos); DEFILED

a derivative of 3392; unsoiled, i.e. (figuratively) **pure: undefiled**.

Heb 13:4 ... Marriage is honourable in all, (KJV)

Gen 1:27-28

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; **male and female** created he them.

28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.(KJV)

Gen 2:21-24

21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.

23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.(KJV)

Lev 21:13-15

13 And he shall take a wife in her virginity.

14 A widow, or a divorced woman, or profane, or an harlot, these shall he not take: but he shall take a virgin of his own people to wife.

15 Neither shall he profane his seed among his people: for I the LORD do sanctify

him.(KJV)

1 Cor 7:1-2

1 Now concerning the things whereof **ye wrote unto me**: It is good for a man not to touch a woman.

2 **Nevertheless, to avoid fornication**, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.(KJV)

1 Cor 7:12-16

12 But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

13 And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.

14 For the **unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife**, and the **unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband**: else were your children unclean; but now are they holy.

15 But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. **A brother or a sister** is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath called us to peace.

16 For what knowest thou, O wife, whether thou shalt save thy husband? or how knowest thou, O man, whether thou shalt save thy wife?(KJV)

2 Cor 6:14-18

14 **Be ye not unequally yoked** together with unbelievers: for **what fellowship** hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and **what communion** hath light with darkness?

15 And **what concord** hath Christ with Belial? or **what part** hath he that believeth with an infidel?

16 And **what agreement** hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

17 **Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,**

18 And will be a Father unto you, **and ye shall be my sons and daughters**, saith the Lord Almighty.(KJV)

Eph 6:4

4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.(KJV)

Col 3:17-21

17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

18 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.

19 Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.

20 Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

21 Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.(KJV)

Heb 13:4 ... and the bed undefiled: (KJV)

1 Cor 6:9

9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,(KJV)

2 Cor 6:14-18

14 **Be ye not unequally yoked** together with unbelievers: for **what fellowship** hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and **what communion** hath light with darkness?

15 And **what concord** hath Christ with Belial? or **what part** hath he that believeth with an infidel?

16 And **what agreement** hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Gal 5:19

19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,(KJV)

Gal 5:21

21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.(KJV)

Eph 5:5

5 For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.(KJV)

Col 3:5-6

5 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:

6 For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:(KJV)

Gen 6:1-8

1 And it came to pass, when **men** began to multiply on the face of the earth, and **daughters were born unto them,**

2 That **the sons of God** saw **the daughters of men** that they were fair; and

they took them wives of all which they chose.

3 And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

4 There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when **the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.**

5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

6 And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.(KJV)

The sons of God (KJV)

Job 1:6

6 Now there was a day when **the sons of God** came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.

Luke 3:38

38 Which was the son of Enos, which was the son of Seth, which was the **son of Adam, which was the son of God**.(KJV)

John 1:11-13

11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

12 **But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:**

13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.(KJV)

John 8:40-42

40 But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.

41 Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God.

42 Jesus said unto them, **If God were your Father, ye would love me:** for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.(KJV)

Additional scriptures (KJV)

Exod 33:13

13 Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found grace in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that **I may find grace in thy sight:** and **consider that this nation is thy people.**(KJV)

Exod 33:16-17

16 For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found grace in thy sight? is it not in that **thou goest with us?** so **shall we be separated, I and thy people, from all the people that are upon the face of the earth.**

17 And the LORD said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that thou hast spoken: for thou hast found grace in my sight, and **I know thee by name.**(KJV)

Num 12:1-11

1 And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses **because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian woman.**

2 And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard it.

3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)

4 And the LORD spake suddenly unto Moses, and unto Aaron, and unto Miriam, Come out ye three unto the tabernacle of the congregation. And they three came out.

5 And the LORD came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood in the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam: and they both came forth.

6 And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the LORD will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream.

7 My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house.

8 With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?

9 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed.

10 And the cloud departed from off the tabernacle; and, behold, Miriam became leprous, white as snow: and Aaron looked upon Miriam, and, behold, she was leprous.

11 And Aaron said unto Moses, Alas, my lord, I beseech thee, lay not the sin upon us, wherein we have done foolishly, and wherein we have sinned.(KJV)

Mal 2:14-15

14 Yet ye say, Wherefore? Because the LORD hath been witness between thee and the wife of thy youth, against whom thou hast dealt treacherously: yet is she thy companion, and the wife of thy covenant.

15 And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? **That he might seek a godly seed.** Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth.(KJV)
