

## ONE ANOTHER

**Matt 23:36** Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation. **37** O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not! **38** Behold, your house is left unto you desolate. **39** For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord. **CHAPTER:24: 1** And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple. **2** And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. **3** And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world? **4** And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. **5** For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. **6** And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. **7** For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. **8** All these are the beginning of sorrows. **9** Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.(KJV)

**Matt 24:10** And then shall many be **(1)offended**, and shall **(2)betray** one another, and shall **(3)hate** one another. (KJV)

### Definitions

#### **(1) Offended**

from 4625; to entrap, i.e. trip up (figuratively, stumble [transitively] or entice to sin, apostasy or displeasure): KJV-- (make to) offend.

#### **(2) Betray**

to surrender, i.e yield up, intrust, transmit: KJV-- betray, bring forth, cast, commit, deliver (up), give (over, up), hazard, put in prison, recommend.

#### **(3) Hate**

(hatred); to detest (especially to persecute); by extension, to love less: KJV-- hate (-ful).

**John 13:34** A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. (KJV)

**John 15:12** This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. **13** Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. **14** Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.(KJV)

**John 15:17** These things I command you, that ye love one another. (KJV)

**Rom 12:10** Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in **(1)honour** **(2)preferring** one another; (KJV)

**Definitions:** **(1)in honour-5092** time (tee-may');from 5099; a value, i.e. money paid, or

(concretely and collectively) valuables; by analogy, esteem (especially of the highest degree), or the dignity itself, 1) a valuing by which the price is fixed b) used of the price paid or received for a person or thing bought or sold 2) honor which belongs or is shown to one: KJV-- honour, precious, price, some. **(2) Preferring** from 4253 and 2233; to lead the way for others, i.e. show deference: KJV-- prefer.

**Rom 13:8** Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. (KJV)

**Rom 14:13** Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way. (KJV)

**Rom 15:7** Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God. (KJV)

**Rom 15:14** And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to **(1)admonish** one another. (KJV)

**Definition:** **(1) Admonish** to put in mind, i.e. (by implication) to caution or reprove gently: KJV- - admonish, warn.

**Rom 16:16** Salute one another with an holy kiss. The churches of Christ salute you. (KJV)

**1 Cor 16:20** All the brethren greet you. Greet ye one another with an holy kiss. (KJV)

**2 Cor 13:12** Greet one another with an holy kiss. (KJV)

**Gal 5:13** For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. **14** For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. **15** But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another. **16** This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. **17** For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.(KJV)

**Gal 5:26** Let us not be **(1)desirous of vain glory**, **(2)provoking** one another, **(3)envying** one another.

**Definitions:** **(1)**Let us NOT be **desirous of vain glory** 2755 kenodoxos (ken-od'-ox-os); from 2756 and 1391; vainly glorifying, i.e. self-conceited, 2756 kenos-empty, vain, devoid of truth a) used of places, vessels, etc. which contain nothing b) used of men 1) empty-handed 2) without a gift c) metaphorically, destitute of spiritual wealth, of one who boasts of his faith as a transcendent possession, yet is without the fruits of faith d) metaphorically, used of endeavors, labors, acts, which result in nothing, vain, fruitless, without effect, vain of no purpose: KJV-- desirous of vain-glory. **(2) Provoking** ;to call forth to oneself (challenge), i.e. (by implication) to irritate: provoke. **(3) Envy**ing; from 5355; to be jealous of: KJV-- envy.

**Eph 4:2** With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, **(1) forbearing** one another in love;

**Definition: (1) Forbearing** ;to hold oneself up against, i.e. (figuratively) put up with: bear with, endure, forbear, suffer.

**Eph 4:32** And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. (KJV)

**Col 3:13** Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. (KJV)

**Col 3:16** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

**1Thes 4:9** But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another. (KJV)

**1Thes 4:16** For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: **17** Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. **18** Wherefore comfort one another with these words. (KJV)

**1Thes 5:11** Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do. (KJV)

**Titus 3:3** For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. (KJV)

**Heb 3:13** But **(1) exhort** one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. (KJV)

**Definition: (1) Exhort**; to address, to speak to, (call to, call upon), entreaty, comfort, instruction, etc. to beg, to entreat, to beseech, to console, to encourage and strengthen by consolation

**Heb 10:24** And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works **25** Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. (KJV)

**1 Pet 1:22** Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: (intensely) (KJV)

**1 Pet 5:14** Greet ye one another with a kiss of charity. Peace be with you all that are in Christ Jesus. Amen. (KJV)

**I Jn 3:11**

11 For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

**I Jn 3:23** And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. (KJV)

**I Jn 4:7** Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. (KJV)

**I Jn 4:11** Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. (KJV)

**I Jn 4:12** No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us. (KJV)

**II Jn 1:5** And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. (KJV)
