

Quit you like men, be strong!

1 Cor 16:13 Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, (1)quit you like men, be strong.(KJV)

(1)quit you like men-407 andrizomai (an-drid'-zom-ahee); middle voice from 435; to act manly, 1) to make a man of or make brave 2) to show oneself a man, be brave: KJV-- quit like men.

1 Cor 16:13 ... Watch ye, (KJV)

Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: **18 Praying always** with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;(KJV)

Col 4:2 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;(KJV)

1 Pet 4:7 But the end of all things is at hand: **be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.**(KJV)

1 Pet 5:7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you. **8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:** (KJV)

1 Cor 16:13 ... stand fast in the faith, (KJV)

1 Cor 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and **wherein ye stand; 2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory** what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.(KJV)

1 Cor 15:58 Therefore, **my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord,** forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain IN THE LORD.(KJV)

Phil 4:1 Therefore, **my brethren dearly beloved** and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast IN THE LORD, my dearly beloved.(KJV)

Col 1:23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, **and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel,** which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister; 24 Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, **which is the church:**(KJV)

1Thes 3:7 Therefore, brethren, we were comforted over you in all our affliction and distress by your faith: **8 For now we live, if ye stand fast IN THE LORD.**(KJV)

II Th 2:15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.(KJV)

1 Cor 16:13 ... quit you like men, (KJV)

1 Cor 7:29 But this I say, brethren, the time is short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none; 30 And they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that rejoice, as though they rejoiced not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not; 31 And they that (1)use this world, as not (2)abusing it: for the fashion of this world passeth away.

Definitions:

(1)use this world-5530 chraomai (khrah'-om-ahee); middle voice of a primary verb (perhaps rather from 5495, to handle); to furnish what is needed; (give an oracle, "graze" [**touch slightly**], **light upon**, etc.), i.e. (by implication) to employ or (by extension) to act towards one in a given manner: KJV-- entreat, use. Compare 5531; 5534.

(2) as not **abusing** it-2710 katachraomai (kat-akh-rah'-om-ahee); from 2596 and 5530; **to overuse, i.e. misuse**: KJV-- abuse.

1 Cor 9:24 Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? **So run, that ye may obtain.** **25** And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. **Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.** **26** I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air: **27** But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.(KJV)

1 Cor 14:20 **Brethren, be not children in understanding:** howbeit in malice be ye children, **but in understanding be men.**(KJV)

Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. **11** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. **12** For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. **13** Wherefore take unto you **the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.** **14** Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; **15** And your feet shod with the preparation of the **gospel of peace;** **16** Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. **17** And take the **helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;**

1 Tim 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.(KJV)

2 Tim 2:3 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier OF JESUS CHRIST. **4** No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may PLEASE him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. **5** And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, **except he strive lawfully.**(KJV)

2 Tim 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, **I have kept the faith: 8** Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing. **9** Do thy diligence to come shortly unto me: **10** For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.(KJV)

1 Cor 16:13 ... be strong. (KJV)

2 Cor 12:6 For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; **for I will say the truth:** but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me to be, or that he heareth of me. **7** And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. **8** For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. **9** And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. **10** **Therefore I take pleasure** in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses **for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.**(KJV)

Eph 6:10 Finally, my **brethren, be strong IN THE LORD,** and in the power of his might. **11** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.(KJV)

Col 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, **do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10** That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; 11 **Strengthened** with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness; **12** Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: 13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: 14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: **15** Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: **16** For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: **17** And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. **18** And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence. 19 For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; (KJV)

2 Tim 1:18 The Lord grant unto him **that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day:** and in how many things he ministered unto me at Ephesus, thou knowest very well.

2 Tim 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, **be strong in the grace that is IN CHRIST JESUS. 2** And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.(KJV)
