

GOD'S INSTRUCTIONS
ON RAISING CHILDREN AND THE
CONSEQUENCES OF NOT FOLLOWING THEM.

Deut 8:5-6

5 Thou shalt also consider in thine heart, that, as a **man chasteneth his son**, so the **LORD thy God chasteneth thee**.

6 Therefore **thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.**(KJV)

Deut 21:18-21

18 If a man **have a stubborn and rebellious son**, which **will not obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother**, and that, **when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them**:

19 **Then shall his father and his mother lay hold on him**, and bring him out unto the elders of his city, and unto the gate of his place;

20 And they shall say unto the elders of his city, **This our son is stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton, and a drunkard.**

21 And **all the men of his city shall stone him with stones, that he die**: so shalt thou put evil away from among you; and all Israel shall hear, and fear.(KJV)

Prov 3:11-12

11 My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:

12 For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth. (KJV)

Prov 4:1

1 Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding. (KJV)

Prov 13:24

24 He that **spareth his rod hateth his son**: but he that **loveth him chasteneth him betimes**. (Early)

Prov 19:18

18 Chasten thy son **while there is hope**, and **let not thy soul spare for his crying**.(KJV)

Prov 22:15

15 **Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child**; but the **rod of correction shall drive it far from him**.(KJV)

Prov 23:13-23

13 **Withhold not correction from the child**: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die.

14 Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and **shalt deliver his soul from hell**.

15 My son, if thine heart be wise, my heart shall rejoice, even mine.

16 Yea, my reins shall rejoice, when thy lips speak right things.
17 Let not thine heart envy sinners: but be thou in the fear of the LORD all the day long.
18 For surely there is an end; and thine expectation shall not be cut off.
19 Hear thou, my son, and be wise, and guide thine heart in the way.
20 Be not among winebibbers; among riotous eaters of flesh:
21 For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe a man with rags.
22 Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.
23 Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.(KJV)

Prov 29:15

15 **The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.**(KJV)

Prov 29:17

17 Correct thy son, and **he shall give thee rest**; yea, **he shall give delight unto thy soul.**(KJV)

Matt 10:32-38

32 Whosoever therefore **shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.**

33 But whosoever **shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.**

34 **Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.**

35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

36 **And a man's (1)foes shall be they of his own household.**

37 He that **loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me**: and **he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.**

38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.(KJV)

Definitions: (1) Foes-(to hate); hateful (passively, odious, or actively, hostile); an adversary (especially Satan): -- enemy, foe.hostile, hating, and opposing another, used of men as at enmity with God because of their sin, opposing (God) in the mind, a man that is hostile, the hostile one, the Devil who is the most bitter enemy of the divine government

Prov 22:15.... Foolishness is bound in the heart. (KJV)

Mark 7:22-23

22 **Thefts**, covetousness, wickedness, **deceit**, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, **pride**, **foolishness**:

23 **All these evil things** come from within, and **defile the man.**(KJV)

2 Cor 6:14-18

14 Be ye **not unequally yoked together with unbelievers**: for **what fellowship** hath

righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

15 And **what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?**

16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

17 Wherefore **come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord**, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.(KJV)

2 Cor 7:1

1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us **cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit**, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.(KJV)

1 Cor 11:32

32 But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should **not be condemned with the world.**(KJV)

Gal 5:16-18

16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

17 For the **flesh lusteth against the Spirit**, and the **Spirit against the flesh**: and **these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.**

18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. (KJV)

Eph 6:1

1 Children, obey your parents **in the Lord**: for this is right.(KJV)

Eph 6:4

4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but **bring them up in the (1)nurture and (2)admonition of the Lord.**(KJV)

Definitions: (1) Nurture-from 3811; tutorage, i.e. education or training; by implication, **disciplinary correction**: KJV-- **chastening, chastisement**, instruction, nurture. **(2) Admonition**-from 3563 and a derivative of 5087; calling attention to, i.e. (by implication) mild rebuke or warning: KJV-- admonition.

Col 3:20-21

20 Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

21 Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged. (KJV)

II Th 3:6

6 Now **we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ**, that ye **withdraw yourselves from every brother that (1)walketh (2)disorderly**, and **not after the tradition which he received of us.**(KJV)

Definitions: (1) **Walketh**-from 4012 and 3961; to tread all around, **i.e. walk at large** (especially as proof of ability); figuratively, **to live**, deport oneself, **follow (as a companion or votary):** -- go, be occupied with, walk (about). (2) **Disorderly** -irregularly (morally): - disorderly.from ; **unarranged**, i.e. (by implication) **insubordinate** (religiously): KJV-- **unruly**.

Heb 12:5-8

5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

6 For **whom the Lord loveth he (1)chasteneth**, and **(2)scourgeth every son whom he receiveth**.

7 If ye endure chastening, **God dealeth with you as with sons**; for **what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?**

8 But if ye be **without (1)chastisement, whereof all are partakers**, then **are ye bastards, and not sons.**(KJV)

Definitions: (1) **Chastisement**-to train children, to be instructed, to be taught, or to learn, to chastise, to **chastise with blows, to scourge**, used of a father punishing his son, used of a judge ordering one to be scourged. (2) **Scourge**from 3148; **to flog** (literally or figuratively): KJV-- scourge.

Heb 12:11

11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: **nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby**.

I Jn 5:19

19 And we know that we are of God, and the whole world **(1)lieth in wickedness.**(KJV)

Definition: (1) **Lieth** middle voice of a primary verb; **to lie outstretched** (literally or figuratively), 2) metaphorically: a) to be (by God's intent) set., that is, destined, appointed c) lies in the power of the Evil One., that is, is held in subjection by the Devil: KJV-- **be (appointed, laid up, made, set)**, lay, lie. Compare 5087.

I Jn 2:15-16

15 **(1)Love not the (2)world, neither the things that are in the world**. If any man love the world, **the love of the Father is not in him**.

16 **For all that is in the world**, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, **is not of the Father, but is of the world.**(KJV)

Definitions: (1) **Love** 1)used of persons: **to welcome, to entertain, to be fond of, to love dearly** 2) used of things: to be well pleased, **to be contented at or with a thing**. (2)**the world** 2889 kosmos-1) an apt and harmonious arrangement or constitution, order, government 2) ornament, decoration, adornment, that is, the arrangement of the stars, `the heavenly hosts', as the ornament of the heavens. 1 Pet. 3:3 3) the world, the universe 4) the circle of the earth, the earth 5) the inhabitants of the earth, men, the human race 6) **the ungodly multitude; the whole mass of men**

alienated from God, and therefore hostile to the cause of Christ 7) world affairs, the aggregate of things earthly the whole circle of earthly goods, endowments riches, advantages, pleasures, etc., which although hollow and frail and fleeting, stir desire, seduce from God and are obstacles to the cause of Christ.
