

**RESTORE AGAIN
THE
KINGDOM TO ISRAEL**

Acts 1:1-8

1 The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,

2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that **he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the*apostles whom he had chosen:**

3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

4 And, **being assembled together with*them, commanded*them that*they** should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.

5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

6 When***they** therefore were come together,***they** asked of him, saying, **Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?**

7 **And he said unto*them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.**

8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be **witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.** (KJV)

THE RESTORATION OF ISRAEL SPOKEN OF BY GOD, IN THE OLD TESTAMENT.

Isa 9:6-7

6 For unto **us a child is born, unto us a son is given:** and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and **his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.**

7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. (KJV)

Jer 23:5-8

5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

7 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that they shall no more say, The LORD liveth, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;

8 But, The LORD liveth, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I had driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land.

Ezek 37:24-28

24 And David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

25 And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David shall be their prince for ever.

26 Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.

27 My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

28 And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore. (KJV)

Hosea 3:4-5

4 For the children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without a sacrifice, and without an image, and without an ephod, and without teraphim:

5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days. (KJV)

Joel 3:16-17

16 The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD will be the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.

17 So shall ye know that I am the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more. (KJV)

Amos 9:11

11 In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:

Zeph 3:15-17

15 The LORD hath taken away thy judgments, he hath cast out thine enemy: the king of Israel, even the LORD, is in the midst of thee: thou shalt not see evil any more.

16 In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, Fear thou not: and to Zion, Let not thine hands be slack.

17 The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing. (KJV)

Zech 9:9

9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, **thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.** (KJV)

THE APOSTLE JOHN TELLS US ABOUT THOSE THAT ARE OF GOD.

John 8:47

47 **He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.** (KJV)

The same god that spoke of the restoration of the Jews in the Old Testament, now tells **Christians** who must be heard, if salvation is expected!

Matt 3:16-17

16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. (KJV)

Matt 17:5

5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and **behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.** (KJV)

JAMES WARNS US OF BEING HEARERS ONLY!

James 1:21-22

21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and **receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.**

22 **But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.** (KJV)

Now, let's hear what Christ has to say in the New Testament, about the restoration of the Jews. The Jews would not hear him or be baptized into him, just as they are today. We must remember a Christian is the wife and follower of CHRIST!

Acts 1:6

6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, **Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?** (KJV)

Matt 20:20-23

20 Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's(**An Israelite**) children with her sons, worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him.

21 And he said unto her, What wilt thou? She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom.

22 But Jesus answered and said, **Ye know not what ye ask.** Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

23 **And he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.** (KJV)

Luke 22:27-30

27 For whether is greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? is not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth.

28 **Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations.**

29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;

30 That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel. (KJV)

Matt 23:27-39

27 **Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!** for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness.

28 Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

29 **Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!** because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

30 And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.

31 **Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets.**

32 Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.

33 **Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?**

34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city:

35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

36 Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.

37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!

38 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.

39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord. (see James 1:21-22)

Matt 24:1-8

1 And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple.

2 And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?

4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

8 **All these are the beginning of sorrows.** (KJV)

Acts 1:6 ... additional scriptures (KJV)

Luke 17:20-23

20 And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, **The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:**

21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, **the kingdom of God is within you.**

22 **And he said unto the disciples,** The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of man, and ye shall not see it.

23 And they shall say to you, See here; or, see there: go not after them, nor follow them.

Luke 19:11

11 And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, **because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear.**

Acts 3:18-22

18 But those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ should suffer, he hath so fulfilled.

19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

20 **And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you:**

21 Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

22 **For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.** (KJV)

Acts 17:24-28

24 God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, **dwelleth not in temples made with hands;**

25 Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;

26 And **hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth,** and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation;

27 That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us:

28 **For in him we live, and move, and have our being;** as certain also of your own poets have said, **For we are also his offspring.** (KJV)

John 5:26-29

26 For as the Father hath life in himself; **so hath he given to the Son to have life in**

himself;

27 **And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.**

28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. (KJV)

John 11:24-27

24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

27 She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: **I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.**

One of the steps into Christ, is the same confession that martha made in verse 27. “i believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God”. This is the same confession all must make, including the Jews to become a Christian, (the wife and follower of Christ). Then, the restoration of the kingdom will begin for the Jews, that faint not.

Col 1:16-19

16 **For by him were all things created**, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

19 **For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;**

Heb 1:1-4

1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

2 **Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

According to New Testament scriptures a **true Christian (the wife and follower of Christ)** have not the right to restore anything to the Jews. There are no instructions left by Christ concerning the restoration of Israel. God will restore in his own time, through their **obedience of his Son Christ Jesus**.

THESE ARE THE INSTRUCTIONS LEFT BY CHRIST:

Matt 28:18-20

18 And **Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me** in heaven and in earth.

19 **Go ye** therefore, and **teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:**

20 **Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you:** and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.(KJV)

NOTE, VERSE 19 OF Matt.28 “teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:” THIS INCLUDES THE JEWS.

We must remember, converting the Jews to Christianity was one of Christ’s missions while he was upon the earth. So why should it change now? Many Jews in that day, just as today, denied that Jesus was and is the Christ. This is what the scriptures call (anti-christ):

I Jn 2:22-23

22 **Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.**

23 **Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father:** (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also. (KJV)

There is no difference between Jews, Muslims, Americans or anyone else **that denies that Jesus is the Christ**, not only in speech, but in deed also. All are (**anti-christs**), and **have not the Father or the Son in them, according to scriptures. True Christians** have no obligation to, one (**anti-christ**) over the other, but to teach Christ. What is given to one, must be given to the other; thereby creating peace. this is the example & mind of Christ, for god is not a respecter of persons (**acts 10:34**). **True Christians must** also remember that the scriptures teach us that **all nations are of one blood (acts17:26)** and that **all nations are blessed through Abraham (gal. 3:8)**. There should not be any special treatment to any one nation. Again, the Jews just as all other nations must be baptized into Christ, thereby putting on Christ. Then are they Abraham’s seed, lets read:

Rom 6:16-17

16 **Know ye not**, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have **obeyed from the heart that (1)form of doctrine which was delivered you.**(KJV)

Definitions: (1) FORM; the mark of a stroke or blow, a print : the teaching which embodies the sum and substance of religion and represents it to the mind, the manner of writing, the contents and form of a letter

Gal 3:27-29

27 **For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.**

28 **There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither **bond nor free**, there is neither **male nor female**: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.**

29 **And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.**(KJV)

Eph 2:14-16

14 For he is our peace, who **hath made both one**,(Jew and Greek) and **hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us**;

15 Having **abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances**; for to make in himself of **twain one new man**, so making peace;

16 And that he might **reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross**, having slain the enmity thereby:

Eph 2:18

18 For **through him** (Jesus) we **both have access by one Spirit unto the Father**.

When we ask god to bless America, never asking him to bless all nations, are we of GOD? True Christians MUST ask god, through Christ Jesus, to bless even their enemies (Luke 6:27-28), this is the mind of Christ. For GOD is not a respecter of persons! We must remember, Christians are not under (the old law / law of Moses / the Ten Commandments / schoolmaster) any more, but the law and commandments of Christ (the New Testament).

Acts 13:38-39

38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:

39 And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which **ye could not be justified by the law of Moses**. (KJV)

Gal 3:24-27

24 Wherefore **the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ**, that we might be justified by faith.

25 **But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster**.

26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

27 **For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ**. (KJV)

Rom 10:4-5

4 For **Christ is the end of the law** for righteousness to every one that believeth.

5 For **Moses describeth the righteousness which is of the law**, That the man which doeth those things shall live by them. (KJV)

Gal 2:21

21 I do not **(1)frustrate the grace of God**: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

Definitions: (1)¹¹⁴ atheteo (ath-et-eh'-o); **-(Frustrate)to set aside**, i.e. (by implication) to disesteem, **neutralize or violate**: KJV-- **cast off, despise, disannul, frustrate, bring to nought, reject**.

Gal 5:1-4

- 1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- 2 Behold, I Paul say unto you, that if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit you nothing.
- 3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.
- 4 Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace. (KJV)

Heb 7:11-12

- 11 **If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?**
- 12 **For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law.** (KJV)

Heb 7:15-16

- 15 And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest,
- 16 **Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life.** (KJV)

Heb 7:17-19

- 17 For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.
- 18 For there is verily a **(1)disannulling of the commandment** going before for the **weakness** and **(2)unprofitableness thereof.**
- 19 For **the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God.** (KJV)

Definitions: (1)Disannulling-from 114; **cancellation** (literally or figuratively): KJV--disannulling, **put away, abolition, , rejection.** **(2)Unprofitableness**-unprofitable, **useless**

Heb 7:22

- 22 By so much was **Jesus made a surety of a better testament.** (KJV)

Heb 8:6-7

- 6 But now hath he obtained a **more excellent ministry**, by how much also he is the **mediator of a better covenant**, which was **established upon better promises.**
- 7 For **if that first covenant had been faultless**, then should no place have been sought **for the second.** (KJV)

Heb 8:13

- 13 In that he saith, **A new covenant, he hath made the first old.** Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready **to vanish away.** (KJV)

Col 2:14

14 **Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances** that was against us, which was contrary to us, and **took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;** (KJV)

1 Cor 11:1-3

1 **Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.**

2 Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and **keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you.**

3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.(KJV)

1 Cor 11:23

23 **For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you,** That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:(KJV)

1 Cor 11:24-25

24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

25 After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye,** as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.(KJV)

1 Cor 11:25 ... the new testament in my blood: (KJV)

Luke 22:20

20 Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.**(KJV)

2 Cor 3:5-7

5 **Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;**

6 Who also hath **made us able ministers of the new testament;** not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.

7 But if the ministration of death, **written and engraven in stones, was glorious,** so that **the children of Israel** could not stedfastly behold the face of **Moses** for the glory of his countenance; **which glory was to be done away:**(KJV)

2 Cor 3:13-16

13 And not as **Moses,** which put a vail over his face, that **the children of Israel** could not stedfastly look to the end **of that which is abolished:**

14 But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same **vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ.**

15 But even unto this day, when **Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart.**

16 Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away.(KJV)

Heb 9:11-20

11 **But Christ** being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;

12 Neither **by the blood of goats and calves,** but **by his own blood** he entered in once into

the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, **sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:**

14 How much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

15 **And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament**, that **by means of death**, for the redemption of the transgressions **that were under the first testament**, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

16 **For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.**

17 **For a testament is of force after men are dead:** otherwise **it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth.**

18 Whereupon neither the first testament was dedicated without blood.

19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,

20 Saying, This is the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you.(KJV)

Heb 13:20-21

20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, **through the blood of the everlasting covenant**,

21 Make you perfect in every good work **to do his will**, working in you that which is **wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ**; to whom be glory for ever and ever.

Amen.(KJV)

This must be remembered, Christians are sanctioned and sanctified by GOD through the **OBEDIENCE** of Christ Jesus; which is **the mediator of the New Testament, not the Old (Heb. 9:15), where disciples were first called Christians.**

Acts 11:25-26

25 Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul:

26 And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. **And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.**(KJV)

We must also remember the order, “**the head of every man is CHRIST**” (1Cor.11:1-3); not Moses, not Aaron of the Levitical priest-hood, and not Elias, but Jesus Christ ONLY.

Matt 17:1-8

1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,

2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

3 And, behold, there appeared unto them **Moses** and **Elias** talking with him.

4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: **if thou wilt**, let us make here **three tabernacles; one for thee**, and **one for Moses**, and **one for Elias**.

5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of

the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**
