

SAVOUREST (FOOD FOR THOUGHT)

Savourest 5426 phroneo (fron-eh'-o);

from 5424; to exercise the mind, i.e. entertain or have a sentiment or opinion; by implication, to be (mentally) disposed; intensively, to interest oneself in (with concern or obedience):

KJV-- set the affection on, (be) care (-ful), (be like-, + be of one, + be of the same, + let this) mind (-ed), regard, savour, think.1) to have understanding, to be wise 2) to feel, to think a) to have an opinion of oneself, to think of oneself, to be of the same mind, that is, agreed together, to cherish the same views, to be harmonious 3) to direct one's mind to a thing, to seek, to strive for a) to seek one's interest or advantage b) to be of one's party, to side with him (in public affairs)

Matt 16:21-27

21 From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

22 Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee.

23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou **savourest not** the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

24 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

25 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it.

26 For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

27 For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.(KJV)

Mark 8:29-38

29 And he saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Peter answereth and saith unto him, Thou art the Christ.

30 And he charged them that they should tell no man of him.

31 And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

32 And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.

33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou **savourest not** the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

34 And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

35 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

36 For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?

37 Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.(KJV)

Acts 28:22

22 But we desire to hear of thee what thou **thinkest**: for as concerning this sect, we know that every where it is spoken against.(KJV)

Rom 8:5-9

5 For they that are after the flesh **do mind** the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

6 For to be carnally **minded** is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

7 Because the carnal **mind** is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.(KJV)

Rom 11:20

20 Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear:(KJV)

Rom 12:3

3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not **to think** of himself more highly than he ought **to think**; but **to think** soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.(KJV)

Rom 12:16

16 Be of the **same mind** one toward another. **Mind not** high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.(KJV)

Rom 14:6

6 He that **regardeth** the day, **regardeth** it unto the Lord; and he that **regardeth** not the day, to the Lord he doth not **regard** it. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.(KJV)

Rom 15:5-7

5 Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to **be likeminded** one toward another according to Christ Jesus:

6 That ye may with **one mind** and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

7 Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God.(KJV)

1 Cor 13:11

11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, **I understood** as a child, **I thought** as a child: but

when I became a man, I put away childish things.(KJV)

2 Cor 13:11

11 Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of **one mind**, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.(KJV)

Gal 5:10

10 I have confidence in you through the Lord, that ye will be none otherwise **minded**: but he that troubleth you shall bear his judgment, whosoever he be.(KJV)

Phil 1:7

7 Even as it is meet for me **to think** this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.(KJV)

Phil 2:1-5

1 If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,

2 Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be **likeminded**, having the same love, being of one accord, of one **mind**.

3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of **mind** let each esteem other better than themselves.

4 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

5 Let this **mind** be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:(KJV)

Phil 3:15-17

15 Let **us** therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus **minded**: and if in any thing ye be otherwise **minded**, God shall reveal even this unto you.

16 Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us **mind** the same thing.

17 Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.(KJV)

Phil 3:18-19

18 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:

19 Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who **mind** earthly things.)(KJV)

Phil 4:2

2 I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of the **same mind** in the Lord. (KJV)

Phil 4:10

10 But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your **care** of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also **careful**, but ye lacked opportunity.(KJV)

Col 3:1-3

1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

2 **Set your affection** on things above, not on things on the earth.

3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.(KJV)
