

**BUT NOW, HE THAT HATH A PURSE, LET HIM TAKE IT AND LIKEWISE  
HIS SCRIP  
(Luke 22:36)**

**Matt 10:5-20**

- 5 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not:
- 6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
- 7 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- 9 Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses,
- 10 Nor **(1)scrip** for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet **(2)staves**: for the workman is worthy of his meat.
- 11 And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter, inquire who in it is **(3)worthy**; and there abide till ye go thence.
- 12 And when ye come into an house, **(4)salute** it.
- 13 And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you.
- 14 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.
- 15 Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.
- 16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- 17 But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;
- 18 And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.
- 19 But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.
- 20 For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.(KJV)

**Definitions:** **(1)scrip**-4082 pera (pay'-rah); of uncertain affinity; a wallet or leather pouch for food: KJV-- scrip.2) a leathern sack, in which travelers and shepherds carried their provisions **(2)staves**-4464 rhabdos (hrab'-dos); from the base of 4474; a stick or wand (as a cudgel, a cane or a baton of royalty): KJV-- rod, sceptre, staff. **(3)worthy**-514 axios (ax'-ee-os); probably from 71; deserving, comparable or suitable (as if drawing praise): KJV-- due reward, meet, [un-] worthy.**(4)salute**-782 aspazomai (as-pad'-zom-ahee); from 1 (as a particle of union) and a presumed form of 4685; to enfold in the arms, i.e. (by implication) to salute, (figuratively) to welcome: KJV-- embrace, greet, salute, take leave.

**Mark 6:7-9**

- 7 And he called unto him the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;
- 8 And commanded them that they should take nothing for their journey, save a staff only;

no scrip, no bread, no money in their purse:

9 But be shod with sandals; and not put on two coats.(KJV)

### **Luke 9:1-3**

1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

3 And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.(KJV)

### **Luke 9:62-10:1-4**

62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

## **CHAPTER 10**

1 After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come.

2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.

3 Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.

4 Carry neither purse, nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man by the way.(KJV)

### **Luke 22:28-40**

28 Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations.

29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;

30 That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat:

32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

33 And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death.

34 And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me.

35 And he said unto them, **When I sent you** without purse, and scrip, and shoes, **(1)lacked ye any thing?** And they said, Nothing.

36 Then said he unto them, **But now, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise his scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.**

37 For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end.

38 And they said, Lord, behold, here are two swords. And he said unto them, It is enough.

39 And he came out, and went, as he was wont, to the mount of Olives; and his disciples also followed him.

40 And when he was at the place, he said unto them, Pray that ye enter not into temptation. (KJV)

**Definition: (1)lacked ye any thing-5302** hustereo (hoos-ter-eh'-o); from 5306; to be later, i.e. (by implication) to be inferior; generally, to fall short (be deficient): KJV-- come behind (short), be destitute, fail, lack, suffer need, (be in) want, be the worse.

**Luke 22:45-51**

45 And when he rose up from prayer, and was come to his disciples, he found them sleeping for sorrow,

46 And said unto them, Why sleep ye? rise and pray, lest ye enter into temptation.

47 And while he yet spake, behold a multitude, and he that was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them, and drew near unto Jesus to kiss him.

48 But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?

49 When they which were about him saw what would follow, **they said unto him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword?**

50 And **one of them smote the servant** of the high priest, **and cut off his right ear.**

51 And Jesus answered and said, **Suffer ye thus far.** And he **touched his ear, and healed him.**(KJV)

**.....he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.....**

**Matt 26:51-52**

51 And, behold, one of them which were with Jesus stretched out his hand, and drew his sword, and struck a servant of the high priest's, and smote off his ear.

52 Then said **Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place:** for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.(KJV)

**Acts 10:12-13**

12 Wherein were all manner of fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.

13 **And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat.**(KJV)

**Acts 11:6-7**

6 Upon the which when I had fastened mine eyes, I considered, and saw fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.

7 **And I heard a voice saying unto me, Arise, Peter; slay and eat.**(KJV)

**Luke 22:36 ... But now, (KJV)**

**Matt 10:22-25**

22 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

23 But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.

24 The disciple is not above his master, nor the servant above his lord.

25 It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more shall they call them of his household?(KJV)

### **John 15:19-20**

19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.(KJV)

### **John 16:32-33**

32 Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me.

33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.(KJV)

### **1Thes 2:14-15**

14 For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they have of the Jews:

15 Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men:(KJV)

### **1Thes 3:2-5**

2 And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:

3 That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto.

4 For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; even as it came to pass, and ye know.

5 For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.(KJV)

### **1 Pet 4:1-4**

1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;

2 That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

3 For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and abominable idolatries:

4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:(KJV)

### **1 Cor 9:11-12**

11 If we have sown unto you spiritual things, is it a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things?

12 If others be partakers of this power over you, are not we rather? **Nevertheless** we have not used this power; **but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Christ.**(KJV)

## 1 Cor 9:12 ... but suffer all things, (KJV)

### Acts 18:1-3

1 After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth;

2 And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them.

3 And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and **(1)wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers.(KJV)**

**Definitions: (1)wrought-2038** ergazomai (er-gad'-zom-ahee); middle voice from 2041; to toil (as a task, occupation, etc.), (by implication) effect, be engaged in or with, etc.: KJV-- commit, do, labor for, minister about, trade (by), work.

### Acts 20:32-35

32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

33 I have coveted no man's silver, or gold, or apparel.

34 **Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.**

35 I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive. (KJV)

### 1 Cor 4:11-14

11 Even unto this present hour we both hunger, and thirst, and are naked, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwellingplace;

12 **And labour, working with our own hands:** being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we suffer it:

13 Being defamed, we intreat: we are made as the filth of the world, and are the offscouring of all things unto this day.

14 I write not these things to shame you, but as my beloved sons I warn you.(KJV)

### 1 Cor 4:16

16 Wherefore I beseech you, be ye followers of me.(KJV)

### 1 Cor 9:14-15

14 Even so hath **the Lord ordained** that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.

15 **But I have used none of these things:** neither have I written these things, that it should be so done unto me: for it were better for me to die, than that any man should make my glorying void.(KJV)

### II Th 3:6-15 (see also 1Cor.11:1-3; Phlip.3:17-20, 4:9; 2Pet.3:2)

6 Now **we command you, brethren**, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye

withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and **not after the tradition which he received of us.**

7 For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you;

8 Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that **we might not be chargeable to any of you:**

9 **Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.**

10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

11 For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies.

12 Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread.

13 But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

14 And if any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed.

15 Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.(KJV)
