

SEARCHED THE SCRIPTURES DAILY (Acts17:11)

Acts 17:10 And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews. **11** These were more **(1)noble** than those in Thessalonica, in that they **(2)received** the word with all **(3)readiness** of mind, and **(4)searched** the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Definitions:**(1)noble**-2104 eugenes (yoog-en'-ace); from 2095 and 1096; well born, i.e. (literally) high in rank, or (figuratively) generous, **2) noble-minded:** KJV-- more noble, nobleman....**(2)received** the word -1209 dechomai (dekh'-om-ahēe); middle voice of a primary verb; to receive (in various applications, literally or figuratively): KJV-- **accept**, receive, take...**(3)ALL readiness** of mind-4288 prothumia-1) zeal, spirit, **eagerness..(4)searched** the scriptures daily-350 anakrino (an-ak-ree'-no); from 303 and 2919; properly, to scrutinize, i.e. (by implication) **investigate**, interrogate, determine: KJV-- ask, question, **discern**, examine, judge, search to investigate, enquire into, scrutinize, sift, question

Acts 17:11 ... they received the word with all readiness of mind, (KJV)

Job 23:12 Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food. (KJV)

Prov 2:1 My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee; **2** So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding; **3** Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding; **4** If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures; **5** Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God. (KJV)

Prov 8:10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.

Matt 13:23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. (KJV)

Luke 10:38 Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house. **39** And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word. **40** But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me. **41** And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things: **42 But one thing is needful:** and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.(KJV)

Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. **42** And they continued stedfastly in the apostles'

doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.(KJV)

Acts 10:31 And said, Cornelius, thy prayer is heard, and thine alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God. **32** Send therefore to Joppa, and call hither Simon, whose surname is Peter; he is lodged in the house of one Simon a tanner by the sea side: who, when he cometh, shall speak unto thee. **33** Immediately therefore I sent to thee; and thou hast well done that thou art come. Now therefore are we all here present before God, to hear all things that are commanded thee of God.

Phil 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death. **21** For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. **22** But if I live in the flesh, this is the fruit of my labour: yet what I shall choose I wot not. **23** For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better: **24** Nevertheless to abide in the flesh is more needful for you. **25** And having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith; **26** That your rejoicing may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for me by my coming to you again. **27** Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; **28** And in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God. **29** For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake; **30** Having the same conflict which ye saw in me, and now hear to be in me. (KJV)

1Thes 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost: (KJV)

1Thes 2:13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe. (KJV)

II Th 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: **9** Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, **10** And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. **11** And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: **12** That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.(KJV)

James 1:19 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: **20** For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. **21** Wherefore **(1)lay apart (2)all (3)filthiness and (4)superfluity of (5)naughtiness, and (6)receive with (7)meekness the (8)engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.** **22** But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. **23** For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: **24** For he beholdeth himself,

and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.(KJV)

Definitions:(1)**lay apart**-659 apotithemi-to put off, to put aside, to put away...**(2)all**-3956 pas-1) individually: each, every, any, all, the whole, everyone, all things, everything 2) collectively: some of all types....**(3)filthiness**-4507 rhu-paria-1) to make filthy, to befoul 2) to defile, to dishonor 3) to make filthy....**(4)superfluity**-4050 perisseia (per-is-si'-ah);from 4052; surplusage, i.e. superabundance: KJV-- abundance (-ant, [-ly]), superfluity....**(5)naughtiness**-2549 kakia-1) malignity, malice, ill-will, desire to injure 2) wickedness, depravity; wickedness that is not ashamed to break laws 3) evil, trouble....**(6)receive**-1209 dechomai (dekh'-om-ah-ee); middle voice of a primary verb; to receive (in various applications, literally or figuratively): KJV-- accept, receive, take. Compare 2983.....**(7)meekness**-4240 prautes (prah-oo'-tace); from 4239; mildness, i.e. (by implication) humility: KJV-- mildness of disposition, gentleness of spirit, meekness **(8)engrafted**-1721 emphutos (em'-foo-tos); from 1722 and a derivative of 5453; implanted (figuratively), inborn, implanted by nature, implanted by the instruction of others: KJV--engrafted.

1 Pet 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:(KJV)

Acts 17:11 ... and searched the scriptures daily, (KJV)

Ps 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. **3** And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. (KJV)

Ps 119:97 O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day. (KJV)

Mal 3:16 Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. **17** And **they shall be mine**, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and **I will spare them**, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. **18** Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.

Mal 4:1 For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch. **2** But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall. (KJV)

Matt 22:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. (Mark 12:24) (KJV)

John 3:21 But he that **doeth truth** cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are **(1)wrought** in God. (KJV)

Definition:(1)**wrought** in God-2038 ergazomai (er-gad'-zom-ahee); middle voice from 2041; to toil (as a task, occupation, etc.), (by implication) effect, be engaged in or with, etc., a) to exercise, to perform, to commit b) to cause to exist, to produce : KJV-- commit, do, labor for, minister about, trade (by), work.

John 5:39 Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and **they are they which testify of me.** (KJV)

Phil 4:5 Let your moderation be known unto all men. **The Lord is at hand.** **6 (1)Be careful** for nothing; **but in every thing** by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. **7** And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. **8** Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any **(2)virtue**, and if there be any **(3)praise**, **think on these things.** **9** Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you. (KJV)

Definitions:(1)**Be careful** for nothing-3309 merimnao (mer-im-nah'-o); from 3308; to be anxious about, to be troubled with cares, 2) to care for, to look out for (a thing) a) to seek to promote one's interests: KJV-- (be, have) care (-ful), take thought....**(2)virtue**-703 arete (ar-et'-ay); from the same as 730; properly, manliness (valor), i.e. excellence (intrinsic or attributed), 1) a virtuous course of thought, a feeling and action virtue, moral goodness 2) any particular moral excellence, as modesty, purity: KJV-- praise, virtue....**(3)praise**-1868 epainos (ep'-ahee-nos);from 1909 and the base of **134**; laudation; concretely, a commendable thing: KJV-- praise....**134** aineo-1) to praise, to extol, to sing praises in honor to God 2) to allow, to recommend 3) to promise or vow

1Thes 5:21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. (KJV)

1 Tim 4:13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. (KJV)

1 Tim 4:15 Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all. **16** Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee. (KJV)

2 Tim 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. **16** All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: **17** That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Heb 13:20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, **21** Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. **22** And I beseech you, brethren,

(1)suffer the word of exhortation: for I have written a letter unto you in few words.(KJV)

Definition:(1)suffer the word of exhortation-430 anechomai (an-ekh'-om-ahee); middle voice from 303 and 2192; to hold oneself up against, i.e. (figuratively) put up with: KJV-- bear with, endure, forbear, suffer.

2 Pet 1:19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: **20** Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any **(1)private** **(2)interpretation**. **21** For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. (KJV)

Definitions:(1)private-2398 idios-pertaining to oneself, one's own, belonging to oneself... **(2)interpretation**-1955 epilysis (ep-il'-oo-sis);from **1956**; explanation, i.e. application, 1) a **loosening, unloosing** : KJV-- interpretation...**1956** epiluo (ep-ee-loo'-o);from 1909 and 3089; to solve further, i.e. (figuratively) to explain, decide, 1) to unloose, to untie 2) to clear (a controversy), to decide, to settle 3) to explain (what is obscure and hard to understand): KJV-- determine, expound.

2 Pet 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: **2** That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour: **3** Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, **4** And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. **5** For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: **6** Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: **7** But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. **8** But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. **9** The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. **10** But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. **11** Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, **12** Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? **13** Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. **14** Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. **15** And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; **16** As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.

17 Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness. **18 But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.** To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.

I Jn 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. (we know not what spirit we are of Luke 9:55)

I Jn 4:5 They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them. **6** We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. (KJV)

Jude 1:16 These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage. **17** But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ; **18** How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. **19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.** **20** But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, **21** Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. **22** And of some have compassion, making a difference: **23** And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. **24** Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, **25** To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.(KJV)
