

## SOME FOOD FOR THOUGHT

### Matt 5:13-16

- 13 **Ye are the salt of the earth:** but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.
- 14 **Ye are the light of the world.** A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.
- 15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
- 16 **Let your light so shine before men,** that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.(KJV)

### Matt 6:20-24

- 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- 21 For **where your treasure is,** there will your heart be also.
- 22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.
- 23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. **If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!**
- 24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.(KJV)

### John 8:12

- 12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness,** but shall have the light of life.(KJV)

### 1 Tim 2:9-10

- 9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with **(1)shamefacedness** and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;
- 10 **But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.**(KJV)

**(1)Shamefacedness**-127 aidos (ahee-doce'); perhaps from 1 (as a negative particle) and 1492 (through the idea of downcast eyes); bashfulness, i.e. (towards men), modesty or (towards God) awe: KJV-- reverence, shamefacedness.a sense of shame or honor, modesty, bashfulness, reverence, regard for others, respect

**1 Tim 2:9 ... that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, (KJV)**

### 1 Pet 3:3-5

- 3 Whose adorning **let it not be that outward adorning** of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;
- 4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of **a meek and quiet spirit,** which is in the sight of God of great price.
- 5 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:(KJV)

## **2 Cor 10:7**

7 **Do ye look on things after the outward appearance?** If any man trust to himself that he is Christ's, let him of himself think this again, that, as he is Christ's, even so are we Christ's.(KJV)

## **2 Cor 3:2**

2 Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, **known and read of all men:**(KJV)

## **2 Cor 6:14-18**

14 Be ye **not unequally yoked together with unbelievers:** for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and **what communion hath light with darkness?**

15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

17 Wherefore **come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord,** and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.(KJV)

## **Eph 5:6-13**

6 Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.

7 Be not ye therefore partakers with them.

8 For ye were sometimes darkness, **but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:**

9 (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)

10 Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

11 And **have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.**

12 For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.

13 But all things that are reprov'd are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.

## **Phil 3:18-20**

18 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that **they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:**

19 Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, **who mind earthly things.**)

20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:(KJV)

## **1Thes 5:4-5**

4 But ye, brethren, **are not in darkness,** that that day should overtake you as a thief.

5 Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.(KJV)

### **Titus 2:12-15**

12 Teaching us that, **denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live** soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself **a peculiar people, zealous of good works.**

15 These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.

### **James 4:4-8**

4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, **know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.**

5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?

6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.(KJV)

### **1 Pet 2:9**

9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; **that ye should shew forth the praises of him** who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:(KJV)

### **I Jn 1:5-10**

5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

6 **If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:**

7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.(KJV)

### **I Jn 2:15-16**

15 **Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world.** If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
