**WIVES**

**Titus 2:1**

1 **But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:**

**Titus 2:3**

3 The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

5 To be **(1)discreet, (2)chaste, (3)keepers at home, (4)good**, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not **(5)blasphemed**.(KJV)

**Definitions:**

**(1) Discreet**

1) of a sound mind, sane, in one's senses 2) curbing one's desires and impulses, self-controlled, temperate

**(2) Chaste**

1) exciting reverence, venerable, sacred 2) pure a) pure from carnality, chaste, modest

**(3) Keepers at home**

a stayer at home, i.e. domestically inclined (a "good housekeeper"): KJV-- keeper at home. caring for the house, working at home a) the (watch or) keeper of the house, b) keeping at home and taking care of household affairs, c) a domestic

**(ANTONYM; CIVIC, PUBLIC, BUSINESS, OCCUPATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL)**

**(4) Good**

of good constitution or nature, good, pleasant, agreeable, joyful, happy upright, honorable

**(5) Blasted**

to vilify; specially, to speak impiously: KJV-- (speak) blaspheme (-er, -mously, -my), defame, rail on, revile, speak evil.

**Titus 2:5 ... keepers at home, (KJV)**

**Gen 3:13**

13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.(KJV)

### Gen 3:16

16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

### Prov 7:10-11

10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.  
11 (She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house:(KJV)

### Prov 31:10

10 Who can find a virtuous woman? **for her price is far above rubies.**(KJV)

### Prov 31:25

25 **Strength and honour** are her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come.(KJV)

### Prov 31:30

30 **Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain:** but a woman that **feareth the LORD**, she shall be praised.(KJV)

### 1 Tim 2:9-15

9 In like manner also, **that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with (1)shamefacedness and sobriety; NOT with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;**

10 **But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.**

11 Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection.

12 But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

13 For Adam was first formed, then Eve.

14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.

15 Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.(KJV)

### Definitions:

#### (1)shamefacedness ;

perhaps from 1 (as a negative particle) and 1492 (through the idea of downcast eyes); bashfulness, i.e. (towards men), modesty or (towards God) awe: KJV-- reverence, shamefacedness.

1. Indicative of shame; ashamed. 2. Extremely modest or shy; Drawing back from contact or familiarity with others; retiring or reserved, bashful, unassertive.

**(Antonym; Bold, Extroverted, Unreserved, Assertive)**

### 1 Pet 3:1-5

1 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

2 While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.

3 **Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;**

4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the

ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

5 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

### OUTWARD APPEARANCE

#### 1 Cor 11:1-3

1 **Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.**

2 Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you.

3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.(KJV)

#### 2 Cor 10:1-2

1 **Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ, who in presence am base among you,** but being absent am bold toward you:

2 But I beseech you, that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.(KJV)

#### 2 Cor 10:7

7 Do ye look on things after the outward appearance? If any man trust to himself that he is Christ's, let him of himself think this again, that, as he is Christ's, even so are we Christ's.(KJV)

#### 2 Cor 10:10-11

10 For his letters, say they, are weighty and powerful; **but his bodily presence is weak,** and his speech contemptible.

11 Let such an one think this, that, such as we are in word by letters when we are absent, such will we be also in deed when we are present.(KJV)

#### Gal 5:24-26

24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.(KJV)

#### Titus 2:1-2

1 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

#### Gen 3:17-19

17 And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life;

18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field;

19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.(KJV)

### **Gen 3:23-24**

23 Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken.

24 So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.(KJV)

### **Gen 3:19 ... In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, (KJV)**

### **Eph 4:28**

28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, **working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.**(KJV)

### **1Thes 2:9-12**

9 For ye remember, brethren, our labour and travail: for labouring night and day, **because we would not be chargeable unto any of you**, we preached unto you the gospel of God.(KJV)

10 Ye are witnesses, and God also, how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that believe:

11 As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children,

12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

### **1Thes 4:9-12**

9 **But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you:** for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.

10 And indeed ye do it toward all the brethren which are in all Macedonia: but we beseech you, brethren, that ye increase more and more;

11 **And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;**

12 That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing.(KJV)

### **II Th 3:6-15**

6 Now we command you, brethren, **in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.**

7 **For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us:** for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you;

8 Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that we might not be chargeable to any of you:

9 **Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.**

10 For even when we were with you, **this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.**

11 For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies.

12 Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with

quietness they work, and eat their own bread.

13 But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

14 And if any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed.

15 Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.(KJV)

**Eph 4:28 ... that he may have to (KJV)**

**2 Cor 8:1-2**

1 Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia;

2 How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality.(KJV)

**2 Cor 8:12-15**

12 For if there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not.

13 For I mean not that other men be eased, and ye burdened:

14 But by an equality, that now at this time your abundance may be a supply for their want, that their abundance also may be a supply for your want: that there may be equality:

15 As it is written, He that had gathered much had nothing over; and he that had gathered little had no lack.(KJV)

**Eph 4:28 ... give to him that needeth. (KJV)**

**Rom 12:13**

13 Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.(KJV)

**1 Cor 16:1-3**

1 Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye.

2 Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

3 And when I come, whomsoever ye shall approve by your letters, them will I send to bring your liberality unto Jerusalem.(KJV)

**2 Cor 9:12-13**

12 For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God;

13 Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men;

**1 Tim 5:3-10**

3 Honour widows that are widows indeed.

4 But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God.

5 Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day.

6 But she that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth.  
7 And these things give in charge, that they may be blameless.(KJV)  
8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.  
9 Let not a widow be taken into the number under threescore years old, having been the wife of one man,  
10 Well reported of for good works; if she have **brought up children**, if she **have lodged strangers**, if she **have washed the saints' feet**, if she **have relieved the afflicted**, if she have diligently followed every good work.(KJV)

### **1 Tim 5:16**

16 If any man or woman that believeth have widows, let them relieve them, and **let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed.**(KJV)

## **FOOD FOR THOUGHT**

### **Mal 3:8-10**

8 **Will a man rob God?** Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

9 Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation.

10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.(KJV)

### **1 Cor 7:30-31**

30 And they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that rejoice, as though they rejoiced not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not;

31 And **(1)they that use** this world, **as not (2)abusing** it: for the fashion of this world passeth away.

#### **Definitions:**

##### **(1) They that use**

to handle); to furnish what is needed; (give an oracle, "graze" [touch slightly], light upon, etc.), i.e. (by implication) to employ or (by extension) to act towards one in a given manner:

KJV-- entreat, use.

##### **(2) Abusing**

to overuse, i.e. misuse: KJV-- abuse, to use much or excessively or ill.
