

## EXHORTATION

### Heb 3:1-19

**1** Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; **2** Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. **3** For this man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house. **4** For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God. **5** And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after; **6** But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end. **7** Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, **8** Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness: **9** When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years. **10** Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways. **11** So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.) **12** Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. **13** But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. **14** For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end; **15** While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation. **16** For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses. **17** But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness? **18** And to whom swore he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not? **19** So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

### Heb 4:1-3

**1** Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. **2** For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. **3** For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

**Heb 3:13** But **(1)exhort** one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be **(2)hardened** through the **(3)deceitfulness** of **(4)sin**.(KJV)

#### Definitions

**(1) exhort**-3870 parakaleo-1) to call to one's side, to call for, to summon 2) to address, to speak to, (call to, call upon), which may be done in the way of exhortation, comfort, instruction, etc. a) to admonish, b) to beg, to entreat, to beseech, c) to console, to encourage and strengthen by consolation.

**(2) hardened**-4645 skleruno-1) to make hard, to harden 2) metaphorically: b) to be hardened c) to become obstinate or stubborn

**(3) deceitfulness**-539 apate (ap-at'-ay);from 538; delusion: KJV-- deceit (-ful, -fulness), deceivableness (-ving).538 apatao- to cheat, to beguile, to deceive

**(4) sin**-266 hamartia-1) equivalent to 0264 b) to miss the mark c) to err, be mistaken d) to miss or wander from the path of uprightness and honor, to do or go wrong e) to wander from the law of God, to violate God's law, to sin 2) that which is done wrong, sin, an offence, a violation of

the divine law in thought or in act

**Heb 3:13 ... exhort one another (KJV)**

**Acts 11:23** Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.(KJV)

**1Thes 2:11-12**

**11** As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children, **12** That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

**1Thes 5:9-11**

**9** For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, **10** Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him. **11** Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.(KJV)

**2 Tim 3:11-16**

**2 Tim 4:1-4**

**1** I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; **2** Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. **3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; **4** And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.(KJV)

**Heb 10:22-39**

**22** Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. **23** Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) **24** And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: **25** Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. **26** For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, **27** But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. **28** He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: **29** Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? **30** For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. **31** It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. **32** But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye endured a great fight of afflictions; **33** Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used. **34** For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance. **35** Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. **36** For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the

promise. **37** For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry. **38** Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. **39** But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.(KJV)

### **Heb 3:13 ... the deceitfulness of sin. (KJV)**

**Prov 28:26** He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.

**Isa 44:20** He feedeth on ashes: a deceived heart hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, Is there not a lie in my right hand?(KJV)

**Obad 1:3** The pride of thine heart hath deceived thee, thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that saith in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground?(KJV)

### **Eph 4:13-25**

**13** Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: **14** That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; **15** But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: **16** From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love. **17** This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, **18** Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: **19** Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. **20** But ye have not so learned Christ; **21** If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: **22** That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; **23** And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; **24** And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. **25** Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.(KJV)

### **James 1:12-15**

**12** Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. **13** Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: **14** But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. **15** Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.(KJV)

**1 Cor 15:33** Be not **(1)deceived: (1)evil (2)communications (3)corrupt** good manners.(KJV)

#### **Definitions**

**(1)deceived**-4105 planao (plan-ah'-o);from 4106; to (properly, cause to) roam (from safety, truth, or virtue): KJV-- seduced, wander, delusional, to be led away into error and sin .

(2) **evil**-2556 kakos-1) used of a bad nature: not such as it ought to be 2) used of a mode of thinking, feeling, acting: base, wrong, wicked 3) troublesome, injurious, pernicious, destructive.

(3) **communications**-3657 homilia (hom-il-ee'-ah);from 3658; companionship ("homily"), i.e. (by implication) intercourse: KJV-- communication, association together: KJV-- company.

(4) **corrupt**- 5351 phtheiro (fthi'-ro); to spoil (by any process) or (generally) to ruin (especially figuratively, by moral influences, to deprave): KJV-- corrupt (self), defile, destroy.

### **James 1:21-25**

**21** Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. **22** But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. **23** For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: **24** For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. **25** But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.(KJV)

## **THE LOCATION OF THE SCRIPTURES MENTIONED DURING THE AUDIO**

1. Salt of the earth: Matt.5:1-16: this, Christians (followers of Christ), must be.
2. Work out our soul salvation: Phil.2:12-13.
3. Keep ourselves unspotted from the world: James 1:27.
4. Deny ourselves: Luke 9:23; John 12:25-26.
5. Christians (followers of Christ) **must be partakers of the Lord's Sufferings**: 2Cor.1:3-7; 1Pet.2:20-24; 1Pet.4:1, 2, 12-19.
6. Jesus was lead by the Holy Spirit, so must Christians (followers of Christ), **through the scriptures**: Matt.4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13; Rom.8:1-18; 1Cor.6:9-11; whereby when we read: Eph.3:1-5, and gladly receive: Acts2:41-42.
7. Christians (followers of Christ), must know that, all scripture is given by inspiration of God: 2Tim.3:12-17.
8. We all will receive our portion, in the LAST DAY: Ps 11:6-7; Matt 24:48-51; Matt 12:34-37; John 12:47-50; 2 Cor 5:8-11; and their works shall follow them: Rev 14:13.
9. Christians (followers of Christ) must know carnality cannot please God: Rom.8:5-18; Phil 3:16-21; Jude1:17-19.
10. Christians (followers of Christ) must meet: Upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break BREAD, not unleavened bread: Acts 20:6-7; 1 Cor 11:17-34
11. Zeal, but not according to knowledge: Rom 9:31-33; Rom 10:1-5

12. Christians (followers of Christ) must know according to Jesus, we must follow the words of His apostles (apostle's doctrine), if we are to believe on Him: John 17:14 and 20; Acts 2:41-42; 2 Pet 2:1-4; 2 Pet 3:1-3; Jude 1:17-19.

13. Christians, (followers of Christ) must know Christ, the image of God, in the flesh: John 1:1-14; John 12:44-45; John 14:6-9; John 20:24-29; 2 Cor 4:1-5; Phil 2:5-11; Col 1:12-20; Heb 1:1-6; I Jn 5:5-12; (Must see also Mark 16:15-16).

14. Christians (followers of Christ) must know; The law, (the law of Moses) was given by Moses to the children of Israel, and **so was unleavened bread**: Exod. 20:1-22; Deut. 4:44-45; Deut. 5:1-3; Unleavened Bread: Exod. 12:1-20 and 39; 13:6-7; 23:15; 29:2; 34:18, and not by Christ to His body, the church. The bread given by Christ is of the New Testament to the church of and by Him and **it is not unleavened**: Matt. 26:26-28; Mark 14:22-24; Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 10: 16-17; 1 Cor. 11:1-3; and verses 23-34. 15. Whereby when we read: Eph. 3:1-5, and gladly receive: Acts 2:41-42.

16. Christians (followers of Christ) must know SIN can be by thought: Mark 7:14-22

17. Unjust law, addressed by God through Christ and the apostle Paul: 1 Cor. 6:1-10 (According to Jesus, believers are those that believe on him through the words of His apostles: John 17:20; Acts 2: 41-42. Jury Duty: this lesson is available on the website.

18. Christians (followers of Christ) must be and will be a **peculiar people**: Titus 2:11-15; 1 Pet 2:1-12.

19. Christians (followers of Christ) has been commanded to love not the world, neither the things that are in it, but are to hate our lives in this world, just as the Lord and those that followed Him before us: John 12:25-26; Phil. 1:29-30; and chapter 3:16-20; 2 Tim. 2:11-16; James 4:4; 1 Pet. 4:1-2; 1 John 2:15-17.

20. Christians (followers of Christ) must know who The god of this world is: Luke 4:1-13; 2 Cor. 4:1-5; 2 Cor. 11:12-15; Eph 2:1-3; Eph 6:10-18; I Jn 4:4-6; I Jn 5:19-21.

21. Christians (followers of Christ) must know by God's Word, what God hath chosen, thereby knowing what He hath not chosen: Rom. 12:16; 1 Cor 1:1-16; 1 Cor 1:18-31; Luke 6:20-26; Luke 16:19-25; James 2:1-7; James 5:1-6.

22. Christians (followers of Christ) according to scripture, we must not lie one to another, neither must we lie at all, because the father of it Jesus said, is the devil: Col 3:1-10 and verses 12-17; John 8:42-47: and according to Jesus Christ, "... all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone...": Rev 21:6-8.

23. Christians (followers of Christ) must not be deceived, and know according to Jesus, by scripture, that power was given to the devil to deceive the whole world, and to war against the

saints and overcome us: Rev 12:7-12; Rev 13:6-9.

**24.** Christians (followers of Christ) must know according to God through Christ and one of His apostles, the apostle Paul; all have not obeyed the gospel: Rom.10:16. He also shares with us how Faith, which is belief, proven by obedience, cometh: Rom.10:17. He also shares with us how salvation is obtained: Heb.5:8-9.
