

## THE FIVE WHATS

**2 Cor 6:14** Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? **15** And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? **16** And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. **17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, 18** And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

### Definitions:

**Unequally yoke together with**-2086 heterozugeo (het-er-od-zoog-eh'-o); from a compound of 2087 and 2218; to yoke up differently, i.e. (figuratively) to associate discordantly: KJV-- unequally yoke together with.

**Unbelievers**-571 apistos (ap'-is-tos); from 1 (as a negative particle) and 4103; (actively) disbelieving, i.e. without Christian faith (specially, a heathen); (passively) untrustworthy (person), or incredible (thing): KJV-- that believeth not, faithless, incredible thing, infidel, unbeliever (-ing).

**What Fellowship**-3353 metochos (met'-okh-os); from 3348; participant, i.e. (as noun) a sharer; by implication an associate: KJV-- fellow, partaker, partner.

**What Communion**-2842 koinonia (koy-nohn-ee'-ah); from 2844; partnership, i.e. (literally) participation, or (social) intercourse, or (pecuniary) benefaction: KJV-- (to) communicate (-ation), **communion**, (contri-) distribution, fellowship.

**What Concord** 4857 sumphonesis (soom-fo'-nay-sis); from 4856; accordance: KJV-- concord, agreement.

**What Part**-3310 meris (mer-ece'); feminine of 3313; a portion, i.e. province, share or (abstractly) participation,<sup>2</sup>) an assigned part, a portion, a share: KJV-- part (X -akers).

**What Agreement** 4783 sugkatathesis-a putting together or joint deposit (of votes); hence, approval, assent, agreement
