

## THE LAW OF CHRIST

### Gal 6:2-4

2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the **(1)law** of **(2)Christ**.

3 For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

4 But let every man prove his **own work**, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another. (KJV)

**Definitions:** **(1)law** of Christ-3551 nomos (nom'-os); from a primary nemo (to parcel out, especially food or grazing to animals); law (through the idea of prescriptive usage), genitive case (regulation), the Gospel), or figuratively (a principle), anything established, anything received by usage, a custom, a law, a command: a) used of any law whatsoever 1) a law or rule producing a state approved of God, by the observance of which is approved of God 2) a precept or injunction c) the Christian religion: the law demanding faith, the moral instruction given by Christ, especially the precept concerning love: KJV-- law. **(2)Christ**-5547 Christos (khris-tos'); from 5548; anointed, i.e. the Messiah, Christ = "anointed"; the Son of God, an epithet of Jesus: KJV-- Christ.

### Gal 6:2 ... Bear ye one another's burdens, (KJV)

#### Exod 23:5

5 If thou see the ass of him that hateth thee lying under his burden, and wouldest forbear to help him, thou shalt surely help with him. (KJV)

#### Num 11:11-12

11 And Moses said unto the LORD, Wherefore hast thou afflicted thy servant? and wherefore have I not found favour in thy sight, that thou layest the burden of all this people upon me?

12 Have I conceived all this people? have I begotten them, that thou shouldest say unto me, Carry them in thy bosom, as a nursing father beareth the sucking child, unto the land which thou swarest unto their fathers? (KJV)

#### Deut 1:12

12 How can I myself alone bear your cumbrance, and your burden, and your strife?

#### Isa 58:6

6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? (KJV)

#### Matt 8:17

17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. (KJV)

#### Matt 11:29-30

29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. (KJV)

**Luke 11:46**

46 And he said, Woe unto you also, ye lawyers! for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves touch not the burdens with one of your fingers. (KJV)

**Rom 15:1**

1 We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves. (KJV)

**Gal 5:13-14**

13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. (KJV)

**Gal 6:5**

5 For every man shall bear his own burden. (KJV)

**1Thes 5:14**

14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men. (KJV)

**1 Pet 2:24**

24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. (KJV)

**Gal 6:2 ... the law of Christ. (KJV)**

**John 13:14-15**

14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

15 For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. (KJV)

**John 13:34**

34 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. (KJV)

**John 15:12**

12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. (KJV)

**1 Cor 9:21**

21 To them that are without law, as without law, (being not without law to God, but under the law to Christ,) that I might gain them that are without law. (KJV)

**James 2:8**

8 If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well: (KJV)

**I Jn 2:8-11**

8 Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.

9 He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now.

10 He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.

11 But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. (KJV)

**I Jn 4:21**

21 And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also. (KJV)

**Gal 6:2 ... additional scriptures (KJV)**

**Luke 5:7**

7 And they beckoned unto their partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink. (KJV)

**1 Cor 5:5**

5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. (KJV)

**1 Cor 12:26**

26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it. (KJV)

**1 Cor 13:5**

5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; (KJV)

**2 Cor 2:7-8**

7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow.

8 Wherefore I beseech you that ye would confirm your love toward him. (KJV)

**2 Cor 11:29**

29 Who is weak, and I am not weak? who is offended, and I burn not? (KJV)

**Eph 4:2** With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; (KJV)

**Phil 2:26**

26 For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick. (KJV)

**Col 3:13**

13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. (KJV)

**Heb 13:3**

3 Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body. (KJV)

**I Jn 3:11**

11 For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. (KJV)

**I Jn 3:18**

18 My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth. (KJV)

**Rev 2:3**

3 And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted. (KJV)
