

## **THE SUFFERING OF THE LORD ON THE CROSS**

### **Matt 26:67**

67 Then did they spit in his face, and **(1)buffeted him**; and others **(2)smote him** with the palms of their hands, (KJV)

**Definitions: (1)buffeted him**-2852 kolaphizo (kol-af-id'-zo);from a derivative of the base of 2849; to rap with the fist: KJV-- buffet.1) to strike with the fist, to give one a blow with the fist 2) to maltreat, to treat with violence and contumely. **(2)smote him**-4474 rhapizo (hrap-id'-zo);from a derivative of a primary rhepo (to let fall, "rap"); to slap: KJV-- smite (with the palm of the hand). 2) to strike in the face with the palm of the hand, to box the ear

### **Matt 26:67 ... did they spit in his face, (KJV)**

### **Num 12:14**

14 And the LORD said unto Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, should she not be ashamed seven days? let her be shut out from the camp seven days, and after that let her be received in again. (KJV)

### **Deut 25:9**

9 Then shall his brother's wife come unto him in the presence of the elders, and loose his shoe from off his foot, and spit in his face, and shall answer and say, So shall it be done unto that man that will not build up his brother's house. (KJV)

### **Job 30:9-11**

9 And now am I their song, yea, I am their byword.

10 They abhor me, they flee far from me, and spare not to spit in my face.

11 Because he hath loosed my cord, and afflicted me, they have also let loose the bridle before me. (KJV)

### **Isa 50:6**

6 I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting. (KJV)

### **Isa 52:14**

14 As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men: (KJV)

### **Isa 53:3**

3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. (KJV)

### **Matt 27:30**

30 And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head. (KJV)

**Mark 14:65**

65 And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophecy: and the servants did strike him with the palms of their hands. (KJV)

**Mark 15:19**

19 And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing their knees worshipped him. (KJV)

**1 Cor 4:13**

13 Being defamed, we intreat: we are made as the filth of the world, and are the offscouring of all things unto this day. (KJV)

**Heb 12:2**

2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. (KJV)

**Matt 26:67 ... and others smote him with** (KJV)

**Jer 20:2**

2 Then Pashur smote Jeremiah the prophet, and put him in the stocks that were in the high gate of Benjamin, which was by the house of the LORD. (KJV)

**Lam 3:30**

30 He giveth his cheek to him that smiteth him: he is filled full with reproach. (KJV)

**Lam 3:45**

45 Thou hast made us as the offscouring and refuse in the midst of the people. (KJV)

**Matt 5:39**

39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also. (KJV)

**Luke 22:63**

63 And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote him. (KJV)

**John 18:22**

22 And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so? (KJV)

**John 19:3**

3 And said, Hail, King of the Jews! and they smote him with their hands. (KJV)

**Acts 23:2-3**

2 And the high priest Ananias commanded them that stood by him to smite him on the mouth.

3 Then said Paul unto him, God shall smite thee, thou whited wall: for sittest thou to judge me after the law, and commandest me to be smitten contrary to the law? (KJV)

**2 Cor 11:20-21**

20 For ye suffer, if a man bring you into bondage, if a man devour you, if a man take of you, if a man exalt himself, if a man smite you on the face.

21 I speak as concerning reproach, as though we had been weak. Howbeit whereinssoever any is bold, (I speak foolishly,) I am bold also. (KJV)

**Matt 26:67 ... the palms of their hands, (KJV)**

**Micah 5:1**

1 Now gather thyself in troops, O daughter of troops: he hath laid siege against us: they shall smite the judge of Israel with a rod upon the cheek. (KJV)

**Matt 26:67 ... additional scriptures (KJV)**

**Matt 20:19**

19 And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify him: and the third day he shall rise again. (KJV)

**Mark 10:34**

34 And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him: and the third day he shall rise again. (KJV)

**Luke 6:29**

29 And unto him that smiteth thee on the one cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid not to take thy coat also. (KJV)

**Luke 18:32**

32 For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on: (KJV)

**2 Cor 12:7**

7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. (KJV)

**1 Pet 2:20**

20 For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God. (KJV)
