

**Warning Against
Following Traditions Of Men
(Quick Reference)**

Matt 15:7-9

7 Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,
8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their **(1)heart** is far from me.
9 **But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.**(KJV)

Definition: (1)HEART

prolonged from a primary kar (Latin, cor, "heart"); the heart, i.e. (figuratively) **the thoughts or feelings (mind)**; also (by analogy) the middle:
(SEE HEBEWS 4: 11-12)

Matt 17:5-6

5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**
6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.(KJV)

Matt 28:16-20

16 Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where Jesus had appointed them.
17 And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted.
18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.**
19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
20 **Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you:** and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.(KJV)

John 8:47

47 **He that is of God heareth God's words:** ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.(KJV)

John 8:49-51

49 Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.
50 And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth.
51 **Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.**(KJV)

John 17:20-21

20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also **which shall believe on me through their word;**

21 **That they all may be one;** as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: **that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.**(KJV)

1 Cor 11:1-2

1 **Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.**

2 Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you.(KJV)

Phil 3:16-20

16 Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, **let us walk by the same rule, let us (1)mind the same thing.**

17 **Brethren, be followers together of me,** and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

18 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, **that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:**

19 Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, **who (1)mind earthly things.**)

20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:(KJV)

Definition: (1)MIND

from 5424; **to exercise the mind**, i.e. entertain or have a sentiment or opinion; by implication, **to be (mentally) disposed** (more or less earnestly in a certain direction); intensively, **to interest oneself in (with concern or obedience):** KJV-- **set the affection on**, (be) care (-ful), (be like-, + be of one, + be of the same, + let this) mind (-ed), **regard, savour, think.**

Phil 4:9

9 **Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do:** and the God of peace shall be with you.(KJV)

Col 2:5-10

5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

6 **As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:**

7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, **as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.**

8 **Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.**

9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:(KJV)

Col 2:12-17

12 **Buried with him in baptism,** wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

14 **Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances** that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, **nailing it to his cross;**

15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

16 **Let no man therefore judge you (1)in** meat, or **in** drink, or **in** respect of an **(2)holyday**, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:

17 Which are a **(3)shadow** of things to come; **but the body is of Christ.**(KJV)

Definitions: **(1)in**-1722 en- in, by, with, among, etc. **(2)holyday**-1859 heorte (heh-or-tay'); of uncertain affinity; a festival: KJV-- feast, holyday, a festival: hol-i-day (h¹4l⁴¹-d³⁷) *n.* **1.** A day on which custom or the law dictates a halting of general business activity to commemorate or celebrate a particular event. **2.** A religious feast day; a holy day. **3.** A day free from work that one may spend. **(3)shadow**-4639 skia (skee'-ah); apparently a primary word; "shade" or a shadow (literally or figuratively [darkness of error or an adumbration]): KJV-- shadow.a) shade caused by the interception of light **ad·um·brate.** **1.** To give a sketchy outline of. **2.** To prefigure indistinctly; foreshadow. **3.** To disclose partially or guardedly.

Col 2:20-22

20 Wherefore **if ye be dead with Christ from** the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,

21 (Touch not; taste not; handle not;

22 Which all are to perish with the using;) after **the commandments and doctrines of men?** (KJV)

II Th 3:6

6 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and **not after the tradition which he received of us.**(KJV)

1 Tim 1:3-4

3 As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, **that thou mightest charge some that they teach no other doctrine,**

4 Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.(KJV)

1 Tim 4:1-5

1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall **depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;**

2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

3 Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

4 For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

5 For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.(KJV)

1 Tim 4:6-7

6 If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, **nourished up in the words of faith and of good doctrine**, whereunto thou hast attained.

7 **But refuse profane and old wives' fables**, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness.
(KJV)

1 Tim 4:12-13

12 Let no man despise thy youth; **but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.**

13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.(KJV)

Titus 1:13-14

13 This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;

14 **Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men**, that turn from the truth.
(KJV)

Heb 13:8-9

8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

9 **Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines.** For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.(KJV)

James 1:21-22

21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and **receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.**

22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.(KJV)
