

## WALK IN THE SPIRIT IF WE LIVE IN THE SPIRIT

### Gal 5:24-26

- 24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.  
25 **If** we **(1)live** in the **(2)Spirit**, **(3)let us** also **(3)walk** in the Spirit.  
26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.(KJV)

**Definitions:** **(1)live** in-2198 zao (dzah'-o); a primary verb; to live (literally or figuratively): KJV-- life (-time), (a-) live (-ly), quick. **(2)Spirit** 4151 pneuma (pnyoo'-mah); from 4154; a current of air, i.e. breath (blast) or a breeze; by analogy or figuratively, a spirit, i.e. (human) the rational soul, (by implication) vital principle, mental disposition, etc., or (superhuman) an angel, demon, or (divine) God, Christ's spirit, the Holy Spirit: KJV-- ghost, life, spirit (-ual, -ually), mind. Compare 5590. **(3)let us walk in the Spirit** 4748 stoicheo (stoy-kheh'-o); from a derivative of steicho (to range in regular line); to march in (military) rank (keep step), i.e. (figuratively) to conform to virtue and piety: KJV-- walk (orderly).1) to proceed in a row as the march of a soldier, to go in order; metaphorically, to go on prosperously, to turn out well 2) to walk, to direct one's life, to live

### Gal 5:25 ... we live in the Spirit, (KJV)

### John 6:63

- 63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.(KJV)

### Rom 8:1-10

- 1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.  
2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.  
3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:  
4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.  
5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.  
6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.  
7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.  
8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.  
9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.  
10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.(KJV)

### 1 Cor 15:39-50

- 39 All flesh is not the same flesh: but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, and another of birds.

40 There are also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial is one, and the glory of the terrestrial is another.

41 There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars: for one star differeth from another star in glory.

42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:

43 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

46 Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.

47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.

48 As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.

49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.(KJV)

### **2 Cor 3:6**

6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life. (KJV)

### **1 Pet 4:6-11**

6 For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

7 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.

8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.

9 Use hospitality one to another without grudging.

10 As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

11 If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.(KJV)

### **Gal 5:25 ... let us also walk in the Spirit. (KJV)**

### **Gal 5:14-21**

14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

15 But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,  
20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,  
21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, **and such like**: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.(KJV)

#### **Rom 13:14**

14 But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and **make not provision for the flesh**, to fulfil the lusts thereof.(KJV)

#### **Rom 13:14 ... put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, (KJV)**

#### **Gal 3:27**

27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.(KJV)

#### **Eph 4:20-25**

20 But ye have not so learned Christ;  
21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:  
22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;  
23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;  
24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.  
25 Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.(KJV)

#### **Col 3:9-11**

9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;  
10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:  
11 Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.(KJV)

#### **Rom 13:14 ... and make not provision for the flesh, (KJV)**

#### **Rom 8:12-14**

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.  
13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.  
14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. (KJV)

#### **Gal 5:16-17**

16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.  
17 For the flesh **(1)lusteth** against the **(2)Spirit**, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are **(3)contrary** the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that **(4)ye would**. (KJV)

**Definitions:** (1)**lusteth**-1937 epithumeo (ep-ee-thoo-meh'-o);from 1909 and 2372; to set the heart upon, i.e. long for (rightfully or otherwise): 1) to turn upon a thing 2) to have a desire for, to long for, to desire 3) to lust after, to covet; used of those who seek things forbidden: KJV-- covet, desire, would fain, lust (after). (2)**Spirit**-4151 pneuma (pnyoo'-mah); from 4154; a current of air, i.e. breath (blast) or a breeze; by analogy or figuratively, a spirit, i.e. (human) the rational soul, (by implication) vital principle, mental disposition, etc., or (superhuman) an angel, demon, or (divine) God, Christ's spirit, the Holy Spirit: KJV-- ghost, life, **spirit (-ual, -ually), mind**. Compare 5590. (3)**contrary**-480 antikeimai (an-tik'-i-mahee); from 473 and 2749; to lie opposite, i.e. be adverse (figuratively, repugnant) to 1) to be set over against, opposite to 2) to oppose, be adverse to, withstand: KJV-- adversary, be contrary, oppose. (4)**ye would**-2309 thelo or ethelo in certain tenses; theleo and etheleo which are otherwise obsolete --1) to will, to have in mind, to intend a) to be resolved or determined, to purpose b) to desire, to wish c) to love, to like to do a thing, to be fond of doing d) to take delight in, to have pleasure

### **Gal 5:24**

24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. (KJV)

### **Col 3:5-8**

5 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:

6 For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:

7 In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them.

8 But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. (KJV)

### **1 Pet 2:11**

11 Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; (KJV)

### **I Jn 2:15-17**

15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. (KJV)

### **Eph 5:6-17**

6 Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.

7 Be not ye therefore partakers with them.

8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

9 (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)

10 **Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.**

- 11 **And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness**, but rather reprove them.
- 12 For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.
- 13 But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.
- 14 Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.
- 15 See then that ye **(1)walk (2)circumspectly**, not as fools, but as wise,
- 16 Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.
- 17 **Wherefore be ye not unwise**, but understanding what the will of the Lord is. (KJV)

**Definitions:** (1) See then that ye **walk**-4043 peripateo (per-ee-pat-eh'-o);from 4012 and 3961; to tread all around, i.e. walk at large (especially as proof of ability); figuratively, to live, deport oneself, follow (as a companion or votary) 1) to regulate one's life 2) to conduct oneself 3) to pass one's life: KJV-- go, be occupied with, walk (about). **(1)circumspectly**-199 akribos (ak-ree-boce'); adverb from the same as **196**; exactly: KJV-- circumspectly, diligently, perfect (-ly).exactly, accurately, diligently...**196** akribestatos (ak-ree-bes'-ta-tos); superlative of akribes (a derivative of the same as 206); most exact: KJV-- most straitest.
