

WISE IN THIS WORLD

1 Cor 3:18

18 Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be **(1)wise** in this world, let him become a **(2)fool, that he may be wise.** (KJV)

Definitions: **(1)wise** in this world-4680 sophos (sof-os');_akin to saphes (clear); wise (in a most general application) a) skilled, expert: of artificers b) wise, skilled in letters, cultivated, learned 1) used of the Greek philosophers and orators : KJV-- wise. Compare 5429. **(2)** let him become a **fool**-3474 moros (mo-ros'); probably from the base of 3466; dull or stupid (as if shut up), i.e. heedless, (morally) blockhead, (apparently) absurd: KJV-- fool (-ish, X -ishness).

1 Cor 3:18 ... deceive himself. (KJV)

Prov 5:7 Hear me now therefore, O ye children, and depart not from the words of my mouth. (KJV)

Isa 44:20 He feedeth on ashes: a deceived heart hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, Is there not a lie in my right hand? (KJV)

Jer 37:9 Thus saith the LORD; Deceive not yourselves, saying, The Chaldeans shall surely depart from us: for they shall not depart. (KJV)

Luke 21:8 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them.

1 Cor 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, (KJV)

1 Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth.

2 And if any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know. (KJV)

2 Sam 17:14 And Absalom and all the men of Israel said, The counsel of Hushai the Archite is better than the counsel of Ahithophel. For the LORD had appointed to defeat the good counsel of Ahithophel, to the intent that the LORD might bring evil upon Absalom. (KJV)

2 Sam 17:23 And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled his ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father. (KJV)

Esth 7:10 So they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai. Then was the king's wrath pacified. (KJV)

Ps 7:14-15

14 Behold, he travaileth with iniquity, and hath conceived mischief, and brought forth falsehood.

15 He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch which he made. (KJV)

13 Who is a **(1)wise** man and **(2)endued with knowledge** among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works **with (3)meekness** of **(4)wisdom**.

14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

15 This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

18 And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

Definitions:

(1)wise-4680 sophos-wise: a) skilled, expert: of artificers b) wise, skilled in letters, cultivated, learned 1) used of the Greek philosophers and orators

(2)endued with knowledge-1990 epistemon (ep-ee-stay'-mone); from 1987; intelligent, experienced, one having the knowledge of an expert: KJV-- endued with knowledge.

(3)meekness-4240 prautes (prah-oo'-tace);from 4239; mildness, i.e. (by implication) humility: KJV-- meekness.

(4)wisdom-4678 sophia-wisdom, broad and full of intelligence; used of the knowledge of very diverse matters: a) the wisdom which belongs to men 2) the science and learning
