

WORDS OF COMFORT

John 8:47

47 **He that is of God heareth God's words:** ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.(KJV)

Matt 17:1-8(see Matt.16:13-18)

1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,
2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.
3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.
4 Then answered **Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord,** it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here **three tabernacles;** one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.
5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**
6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.
7 And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid.
8 And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, **save Jesus only.**(KJV)

Matt 28:18-20

18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.
19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, **(1)baptizing** them in the **(2)name** of the **Father,** and of the **Son,** and of the **Holy Ghost:**
20 **Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you:** and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.(KJV)

Definitions: (1) Baptizing 907 baptizo (bap-tid'-zo); from a derivative of 911; **to immerse, submerge; to make overwhelmed (i.e. fully wet);** baptism: KJV-- Baptist, baptize, wash.

(2)Name 3686 onoma (on'-om-ah); from a presumed derivative of the base of 1097 (compare 3685); a "name" (literally or figuratively) **[authority, character]:** KJV-- called, (+sur-) name (-d), the name is used for **everything which the name covers,** everything the thought or feeling of which is aroused in the mind by mentioning, hearing, remembering, the name, that is, for one's rank, authority, interests, pleasure, command, excellences, deeds etc. the cause or reason, named: on this account, because he suffers as a **Christian,** for this reason.

Gal 3:26-27

26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
27 For as many of you as **have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.**(KJV)

Rom 10:16-17

16 But they have **not all obeyed the gospel.** For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?
17 So then **faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.**(KJV)

Eph 2:8-9

8 For **by grace are ye saved through faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.(KJV)

Heb 11:1-3

1 Now faith is the **(1)substance** of **(2)things hoped for**, the **(3)evidence** of things not seen.
2 For by it the elders obtained a good report.
3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.(KJV)

Definitions: (1)Substance 5287 hupostasis-a substructure, a **foundation**, what has foundation, **what is firm**, the steadfastness of mind, a firmness, courage, a resolution, **confidence**, firm trust, assurance. **(2)Things Hoped For** 1679 elpizo-to hope; in a religious sense, to wait for salvation with joy and full confidence, hopefully to trust in. **(3)Evidence** 1650 elegchos (el'-eng-khos); proof, conviction: KJV-- evidence, reproof.

James 1:21-24

21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and **receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.**
22 **But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.**
23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:
24 For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.(KJV)

James 2:17-20

17 Even so faith, **if it hath not works**, is dead, being alone.
18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.
19 **Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.**
20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that **faith without works is dead?**(KJV)

Rom 6:17

17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, **but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.**(KJV)

Rom 15:4-6

4 For whatsoever things were **written aforetime were written for our learning**, that we through patience and **comfort of the scriptures might have hope.**
5 Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another **according to Christ Jesus:**
6 That ye may with **one mind and one mouth glorify God**, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.(KJV)

Rom 16:17

17 Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to **the doctrine** which ye have learned; and avoid them.(KJV)

1 Cor 1:10

10 Now I beseech you, brethren, **by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ**, that ye all **speak the same thing**, and that there be **no divisions among you**; but that ye be **perfectly joined together** in the **same mind** and **in the same judgment**.(KJV)

1 Cor 11:1

1 Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.(KJV)

Phil 2:1-5

1 If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,

2 Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, **being of one accord, of one mind**.

3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

4 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:(KJV)

Phil 4:9

9 **Those things**, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.(KJV)

John 17:16-17

16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.(KJV)

Heb 4:11-12

11 Let us **labour therefore to enter into that rest**, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

12 For the **word of God** is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and **is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart**.(KJV)

Heb 10:22-27

22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts ***sprinkled (to cleanse by sprinkling, to purify)** from an evil conscience, and **our bodies washed with pure water**.

23 **Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering**; (for he is faithful that promised;)

24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

26 For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

27 But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.(KJV)

II Jn 1:9-11

9 Whosoever transgresseth, and **abideth not in the doctrine of Christ**, hath not God. He that **abideth in the doctrine of Christ**, he hath both the Father and the Son.

10 If there come any unto you, and bring not **this doctrine**, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed:

11 For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.(KJV)

Rev 14:12-13

12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that **keep the commandments of God**, and the faith of Jesus.

13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, **Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.**(KJV)

1Thes 4:13-18

13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

14 For if we **(1)believe** that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep **in** Jesus will God bring with him.

15 For this we say unto you **by the word of the Lord**, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the **dead in Christ** shall rise first:

17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

18 **Wherefore comfort one another with these words.**(KJV)

Definitions: (1)Believe 4100 pisteuo (pist-yoo'-o); from **4102**; to have faith (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), i.e. credit; by implication, to entrust (especially one's spiritual well-being to Christ): KJV-- believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with. **4102**; from **3982**; persuasion, i.e. credence; moral conviction (of religious truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), especially reliance upon Christ for salvation; abstractly, constancy in such profession; by extension, the system of religious (Gospel) truth itself: KJV-- assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity. **3982**; to convince by analogy, to assent (to evidence or authority), KJV-- agree, assure, believe, have confidence, be (wax) conflent, make friend, **obey**, persuade, trust, yield.

John 9:31

31 Now we know **that God heareth not sinners**: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and **doeth his will**, him he heareth.(KJV)

Eph 6:18-24

18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

22 Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and that he might comfort your hearts.

23 Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

24 **Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.**(KJV)

1 Tim 2:1-4

1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made **for** all men;

2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

4 **Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.**

II Th 2:14-15

14 Whereunto he **called you by our gospel**, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and **hold the traditions which ye have been taught**, whether by word, or our epistle.(KJV)

Acts 4:10-12

10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that **(1)by** the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none **(2)other (3)name** under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.(KJV)

Definitions: **(1)By** 1722 en (en); a primary preposition denoting (fixed) position (in place, time or state). **(2)none Other** 2087 heteros (het'-er-os);other or **different**: KJV-- **altered**, else, **one**, (an-) other, some, **strange**, referring to **quality**: another: that is, one that is not of the same nature, form, class, or kind, to be different. **(3)Name** 3686 onoma (on'-om-ah);from a presumed derivative of the base of 1097 (compare 3685); a "name" (literally or figuratively) [**authority, character**]: KJV-- called, (+sur-) name (-d), the name is used for **everything which the name covers**, everything the thought or feeling of which is aroused in the mind by mentioning, hearing, remembering, the name, that is, for one's rank, authority, interests, pleasure, command, excellences, deeds etc. the cause or reason, named: on this account, because he suffers as a **Christian**, for this reason.

Eph 3:8-21

8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,
11 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:
12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.
13 Wherefore I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.
14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,
16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;
17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,
18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;
19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.
20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,
21 Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.(KJV)

Eph 4:4-6

4 There is **one body**, and **one Spirit**, even as ye are called in **one hope** of your calling;
5 **One Lord, one (1)faith, one baptism,**
6 **One God** and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.(KJV)

Definitions: (1)Faith 4102 pistis (pis'-tis);from **3982**; persuasion, i.e. credence; moral conviction (of religious truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), especially reliance upon Christ for salvation; abstractly, constancy in such profession; by extension, the system of religious (Gospel) truth itself: KJV-- assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity. **3982** to convince by analogy, to assent (to evidence or authority), KJV-- agree, assure, believe, have confidence, be (wax) conflent, make friend, **obey**, persuade, trust, yield.

Eph 5:23-27

23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and **he is the saviour of the body.**
24 Therefore as the **church is subject unto Christ**, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.
25 Husbands, love your wives, even as **Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;**
26 That he might sanctify and cleanse **it** with the **washing of water by the word,**
27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.(KJV)

Eph 5:32

32 This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and **the church.**(KJV)
